

NEW AMBULANCE STATION FOR BEROWRA

FRONTLINE EMERGENCY CARE FOR RESIDENTS IN THE BEROWRA DISTRICT IS SET TO RECEIVE A MAJOR BOOST, WITH THE AREA EARMARKED AS THE FUTURE LOCATION FOR A NEW AMBULANCE STATION.

Member for Hornsby **Matt Kean** welcomed the news, saying, "I am incredibly pleased to announce residents living in Berowra and surrounds will have improved access to emergency care when and where they need it most.

"In identifying Berowra as the future location for a new ambulance station, NSW Ambulance has confirmed what locals have been saying for some time," said Mr Kean.

The new station will feature internal parking for emergency ambulance vehicles, vehicle wash facilities, multipurpose spaces to support staff education and rest, logistics and storage spaces, an office area for administration as well as staff amenities.

"In addition to improved frontline emergency care, the investment will also bring more jobs to our local area as well as providing a better working environment for our paramedics," Mr Kean explained.



The exact location for the new ambulance station will be determined once further planning is completed which includes working with key stakeholders to identify a suitable site.

"With funding committed and Berowra confirmed as the location for a future ambulance station, the next step is to identify potential sites for the build. This process will ensure we best meet the needs of the local community and our emergency staff."

NSW Ambulance uses best-practice modelling software that maps out Triple Zero calls to determine the most suitable location for emergency care, ensuring that new stations are located to support the effective delivery of timely paramedic care to patients across the area. The new ambulance station at Berowra is being delivered as part of the \$615.5 million NSW Ambulance Infrastructure program, which is also delivering a new ambulance station at Cherrybrook.

On SUNDAY 12TH MARCH from 10am to 4pm, at the Berowra Community Centre the Berowra Fauna Fair will commence with a Welcome to Country and smoking ceremony by Uncle Laurie. The centre will be a hub of fauna-based activity including native animals, information from WILDLIFE RESCUE, local PLANTS FOR SALE, a workshop on BUILDING A BEE HOTEL and a BBQ run by Apex. Throughout the event there will be continuous 30-minute talks by experts on bats, birds, frogs, fungi, marine animals, koalas and more.

The greater Hornsby area is a native animal hot spot and home to some of Australia's most iconic animals such as the echidna and threatened species such as the platypus and koala. Learning about these animals is a great step towards making sure they are still here for

future generations to enjoy. With support from a Hornsby Shire Council's Event Grant and participation by the Frog and Tadpole Study Group of NSW, the Cattai-Hills Environment Network, the Australian Plants Society and Sydney Wildlife Rescue.

Friends of Berowra Valley are pleased to be able to expand and run this event for another year.

COWAN QUARRY IN THE SPOTLIGHT

The NSW Government has commissioned a geotechnical investigation into a former sandstone quarry at Cowan to determine if the bushland site could one day be opened to the public for recreation use.

Member for Hornsby, Matt Kean said the study, which is currently being undertaken, will help determine if it would be safe and cost effective to one day open up the former Cowan Quarry site for recreation such as bushwalking and BMX riding, while honouring its heritage value.

"Northern Sydney has some fantastic bushland areas and this Geotech study will help determine if it could be safe and economically feasible to open up this 1.5-hectare spot near Cowan Oval for more open space recreation," Mr Kean said. "First we need to find out if the ground in the in-filled quarry site is sufficiently stable to allow walking and riding over the area.' The former quarry site is in a hilly area accessible via locked vehicle gates off Bujwa Fire Trail near Cowan Oval and at the Pacific Highway entrance to Wedgewood Fire Trail. Cowan Quarry is part of a Crown reserve managed by Crown Lands. Mr Kean said, "This project will try to activate more open space as part of ongoing efforts to maintain and improve Crown reserves across NSW to ensure local communities can enjoy public assets, while still protecting the surrounding environment.'

'POT-HOLE ROAD REPAIRS' **NSW GOVERNMENT SUPPORTS URGENT** LOCAL ROAD REPAIRS IN HORNSBY LGA



An appeal to the NSW Government from a group of Sydney Mayors, led by Hornsby Mayor, Philip Ruddock AO, has resulted in the grant of funding of \$220 million to be shared by thirty-five Sydney councils to repair roads damaged by last year's storms.

The Minister for Metropolitan Roads, Natalie Ward said, "Councils can act now on urgent road and pothole repairs, as well as protect against reoccurring challenges through the use of technology such as cold mix." Member for Hornsby Matt Kean said, "I know how tough it has been for the badly impacted community of Hornsby and this funding will go a long way in delivering immediate

"This funding ensures people across Greater Sydney can have their roads returned to even better condition than they were prior to the record rainfall last year." Hornsby Council has been allocated \$6.9 million and Hornsby Mayor, Philip Ruddock AO said, "While we have been proactive in responding to reports of road damage to ensure safe travel for our residents, we have already expended much of the \$3.2 million we had allocated for road restoration this financial year." "Following numerous representations to the State Government seeking funding for flood and rain damage, including damage to our local roads, we are pleased that the Premier has listened to us and has committed significant funding to help remediate the severe pothole damage across NSW." Mayor Ruddock said.



Hornsby Council continues to take steps to revitalize the westside of Hornsby and celebrate that area's rich heritage.



Funded by a NSW Government Grant through the Your High Street program, Hornsby Council is currently undertaking construction works on the corner of Coronation Street and Jersey Lane, Hornsby. This work is repurposing part of an old carpark area to create a new, permanent micro plaza under a "ghost building", as well as a pop-up community event space. This will reinvigorate an old run-down precinct and increase the area's uses during both the day and evening, whilst improving safety and comfort. The project will also improve accessibility and connections, increase pedestrian traffic and provide a boost for local businesses in the Coronation Street area.

It is anticipated the facility ready for use by May 2023, with the final stage being a street mural to be painted by artist Fintan McGee. The mural will recognize the location's history, being the old Judge's Bakery site. In a second project nearby, Hornsby Council again commissioned the services of renowned artist and muralist, Hugues Sineux, who has just completed a magnificent mural in Beattie Lane, Hornsby (the small laneway between Jersey Lane and Jersey Street front cover & photo above). Sineux is best known in Hornsby for his historic themed "Ginger Meggs" mural in Dural Lane which he painted in 2016. This impressive new mural in Beattie Lane also has a historic Hornsby theme and is well worth checking out. 

PERFORMANCE REPORT

Council also tabled its latest Performance Report, detailing strong progress with its 2022-2026 Delivery Program including the 2022/23 Operational Plan, and Budget outcomes for the first half of the 2022/23 financial year.

Hornsby Shire Mayor Philip Ruddock AO said, "The community has outlined its vision for

the Shire through the Community Strategic Plan and the Delivery Program and Operational Plan roadmap which show how we will achieve these goals.'

"Across the Shire, we spent \$36 million, much of it received as grants from the NSW Government, on services for the community. Completed capital projects included upgrading four parks and playgrounds such as Warrina Street Oval, Berowra and a new dog park at Hunt Reserve. We upgraded four sporting facilities, which included completing the upgrades to the Mark Taylor Oval and we delivered a new indoor cricket centre at this facility. We built a new scenic viewing platform at Quarter Sessions Road in Westleigh and delivered a new accessible path at McKell Park in Brooklyn."

Council resolved to write to the NSW Government, the Opposition, NSW Greens and Independent Members of Parliament calling for support in managing the impacts of cats on the environment in a range of ways. These include changes to the Companion Animals Act 1998 to enable Council to introduce containment policies in consultation with the local community, NSW National Parks and Wildlife Service, the Invasive Species Council, the RSPCA and other agencies to meet the specific needs of the area, including phase-in periods, a selection of areas within the area to which the policy applies and monitoring frameworks including consideration of resource allocation.



The volunteers are generous with their time and genuine in their care, providing invaluable social support, connection, and friendship. It is also rewarding for them in return.



BEROWRA BOY, NEIL DAVIS 6th February 1931 to 18th January 2023

Neil was born at Glenbrook in the Blue Mountains. In 1933, he moved to Berowra with his parents, Bob and Gladys Davis, and his sister, Elaine. Neil's father was appointed Station Master at Berowra and after 44 years working for the NSW Railways, he retired

Initially the Davis family rented a house in Rickard Road for 10 shillings a week, later purchasing this house in 1943. Before WW2, Berowra was a remote outpost and the Davis family home had no power, nor

Neil attended Berowra Public School from 1937 and he always had bare feet at school: in those days shoes were a luxury few could afford, and being shoeless was a practice Neil happily continued throughout his life. Growing up in the Berowra bush, Neil and his friends had great times riding bikes, racing billycarts down steep hills like Hillcrest Road, swimming in Berowra Creek, local waterholes, fishing, camping and playing football.

He also grew up in Berowra during the War. Neil clearly remembered how there were trenches dug on the school grounds to conduct regular air raid practices. On both the school building and at home, all windows were taped up to stop flying glass. The community experienced the severity of war rations, including food and petrol. The army set up a camp between Bambil and Rickard Roads to practice manoeuvres. Of course, as young boys this was very exciting for him and his mates, but in 1941, Neil was sent to Dubbo to stay with relatives for a time due to growing fears of a Japanese invasion via Berowra Waters.

Just after the War had ceased, Berowra was a close-knit community with a small population of around 300. In 1945. Neil's sister Elaine, who was 10 years older than him, married a local man, Bill Foster. Bill's parents ran the well-known Fosters Store, which was the social centre of the community. Bill and Elaine Foster built their home in Goodwyn Road where they raised their family. Bill passed away in July 2012 aged 95, but Elaine lived on to her hundredth year in 2021.

During the 1940s and 50s Berowra's "Younger Set", as they were known, organised social outings to which Neil was a member enjoying Saturday dance nights at Mt Kuring-gai's Harwood Hall, Hornsby Cabaret and in the city. He also relished watching live boxing and wrestling matches at Leichardt Stadium, which included following local boxers, such as Vic Patrick from Brooklyn and Arnold Hamilton from Berowra. Always keen to record memorable moments Neil put together a scrap book of newspaper cuttings and tickets from those events.

In 1953, his father, Bob Davis, gifted Neil a parcel of land at the rear of the Rickard Road family property, which actually fronted Waratah Road. The following year Neil married "a lovely Hornsby girl", Merle Jewell, at St Peters Church in Hornsby. The young couple moved to 8 Waratah Road where they remained and raised their four children Mark, Janelle, Clinton and Michelle

Neil completed his Intermediate Certificate in 1946 at the Hornsby Central Technical School with glowing results. "A steady and hard-working boy," wrote the headmaster. The following year he started a plumbing apprenticeship at Pymble and by 1956 at the age of twenty-six Neil joined Cedric McCready as they set up their own local plumbing business known as, C. McCready & N. Davis, and their partnership ran for 14 years. In 1970, Neil worked for the local concreting company Aston and Burke, as he travelled around NSW constructing bridges. He secured steady employment in 1973, joining Hornsby Council as a plant operator. He was a familiar sight driving a bright yellow Volvo front end loader around the Hornsby area, highly skilful and meticulous when operating that machine, which was very impressive to watch.

In 1996, and on his 65th birthday, Neil retired after 23 years of working at Hornsby Council. Neil was held in the highest regard and a surprise BBQ was organized with over 100 people in attendance. For his exemplary service the General Manager awarded Neil a gold watch, an honour usually reserved only for employees who achieved 25 years' service. Neil proudly kept his watch for the rest of his life.


Neil always kept chooks at home, and they ran free range in the back yard with ducks, pet dogs and even a horse at one stage. He got much pleasure out of gardening and tended to it most days, as well as growing a range of vegetables.

In retirement, Neil thrived on doing jobs around the house and if he didn't have the right tool, he would make one to fit the task. He knew where every single tool was kept out of the hundreds he stored in the garage!

Obsessed with keys, he could have easily set up his own locksmith business, as he had keys and locks for just about everything in the house, garage and yard. Each key was differentiated by a coloured ribbon, however, no one else could crack his colour code! Neil would make detailed and endless lists, ticking off each task as completed: Chop firewood, Clean chook house, * Check fishing gear, * Check rat holes and traps . '

In his retirement years, Neil travelled extensively around Australia with Merle. When they drove their car across the desolate plains of the Nullarbor, Merle was always filling up the car with artefacts and natural items that she collected along the way, to use later for her floral art. As a sixtieth wedding anniversary celebration, Neil and Merle went on The Ghan to Darwin, which was one of their most memorable trips. Recently their family discovered that Neil and Merle came from a generation that never threw anything away and Neil was an avid collector, especially of local memorabilia. He had a crystal-clear memory of growing up in Berowra which he loved to recount whenever given the opportunity. In his younger years Neil was a member of the Berowra Bush Fire Brigade, snow skied at Mt Kosciusko and water skied at Windsor. However, he was not so good at tennis and Merle used to recount that he'd hit the ball far too hard, and it would constantly end up out of the court! Neil also loved lawn bowls and was a very active member of the Berowra Bowling Club, when of course, he wasn't suspended for disruptive behaviour!

In recent times, Neil relished the quietness and focused on reading history books which transported him into another place and time. He particularly loved the weekly visits from his family especially his little great grandchildren. The conversation, the stories and laughs, all mixed with Neil's sharp wit and sense of humour, never waned right up until the end. Sadly, Neil had been struck by an overwhelming grief when he lost the love of his life and soul mate, Merle, last year. I thank Neil Davis' family for providing much of this information about Neil's life.

On a personal note, Neil Davis had a passion for both history and the Berowra district. I would like to recognize him for the generous support he provided me over many years. Along with other recently passed "Berowra Boys" George Thompson and Jim Hatfield, Neil's information, advice and access to family photos greatly assisted me in putting together Berowra's history, particularly during the pre-WW2 period, as it provided first-hand knowledge of that time.
