

Somerville, Liaison Officer between the newly formed Brooklyn Fire Brigade and Hornsby Shire Council, attended together with four Officers from the Fire Board, for a meeting held at the Brooklyn School for the purpose of electing Office-bearers for the Brigade."

"It was resolved on the motion of Mr Robinson, seconded by Mr Bennington, that 'the Brigade, to function under the terms of the Local Government Act, be known as the Brooklyn District Bush Fire Brigade'. This was carried unanimously."

"Mr George Hewitt was elected Captain, Mr A. E. Bennington Secretary, Mr Childs Treasurer and a committee of Mr A.M Ritchie, Mr S.J. Creed, Mr N. Childs, Mr J. E. Smith, and Captain G. Hewitt to be a member ex-officio."

The Brooklyn Rural Fire Brigade is excited to celebrate its 80TH BIRTHDAY with dedicated, passionate volunteers giving their free time to serve the local & surrounding communities.

The first members formed the Brooklyn RFS on 29th June with the first meeting taking place Tuesday 29th. Since then members have met every Tuesday night, even displaying those very first Minutes of that meeting in the station! Led by Captain Tim O'Mahony and Senior Deputy Brad Townsend, the 30-plus volunteers of Brigade are kept busy with anywhere between 140-160 call outs every year protecting the local and river communities from not only bush fires, but also responding to car, truck and boat fires, motor vehicle accidents, storm damage, and even been known to save the odd kitten stuck up a tree!



In March 2022 The Brooklyn Brigade received a brand new fire truck, a CATEGORY 1 TANKER and together with the trusty 'Pumper' and *Fire Boat*, the crew is always ready to respond 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, all year round.

HORNSBY COUNCIL ADOPTS 2023-2026 DELIVERY PROGRAM

Hornsby Shire Council has adopted its 2023-2026 Delivery Program and 2023/24 Operational Plan (DPOP) incorporating the Budget, Rating Structure and Fees and Charges for 2023/24. Hornsby Shire Mayor, **Philip Ruddock** AO said, "For 2023/24, we look forward to delivering tangible results for the community, committing over \$93 million in capital projects, largely funded by external grants and development contributions. As well as progressing our major projects at HORNSBY PARK, WESTLEIGH PARK, AND THE ASQUITH TO MOUNT COLAH PUBLIC DOMAIN IMPROVEMENTS, we'll make improvements to local roads, footpaths, drainage, parks, sporting facilities, bushland and waterways for the benefit of all residents."

By adopting the Rating Structure, Council also determined to apply the first year of the four-year Special Rate Variation approved by IPART.

For more than 10 years, Council has avoided a rate increase for its residents. However, to ensure that Council can continue to support and provide the community with the levels of service it has come to expect through maintaining financial sustainability, it had little option but to apply the SRV at this time.

"We reluctantly put forward the application to IPART to have the rate increase approved, and an independent objective evaluation substantiated what we are seeking to do. We don't do it with any alacrity, we are very reluctant," Mayor Ruddock continued.

To address concerns in the community around financial hardship, Council adopted a revised **Hardship Policy**. Following a review, the Special Circumstances section of the Policy has been broadened and includes all relief that is legally permissible according to the Local Government Act. Further, the pensioner rate concession will increase by \$50, to

\$300 per annum, commencing from the 2023/24 financial year. The 2023-2026 Delivery Program and 2023/24 Operational Plan was on public exhibition from 13 April to 15 May 2023. 67 submissions were received from the community.

MORE UPGRADES ON TRACK FOR WAITARA TRAIN STATION



Additional improvements are being incorporated into the **Waitara Station Upgrade project** to make the facility safer and more accessible, following feedback from the community and Hornsby Council.

"These improvements will provide better access for the many community members who use the western side of Waitara Train Station, particularly to access local schools and retirement facilities," said a Transport for NSW spokesperson.

"The new lifts being installed in the initial upgrade will be more accessible, and we have taken that feedback on board," said the spokesperson. "New works will include better pedestrian access on the Pacific Highway side of the station from the street to the new lift entry in the commuter car park and upgrading the commuter car park to provide approximately 16 extra parking spaces with improved lighting and security."

"We're also extending the platform canopy to offer better weather protection between the new lift and the existing station building." The initial station upgrade, which received approval last year, includes two new station entrances, a new underpass and two new lifts at the northern end of the station.



MORE NEEDS TO BE DONE TO HELP MORTGAGE HOLDERS NAVIGATE RISING INTEREST RATES

Owning your own home is a core part of the Australian dream. We've long been told that if you work hard and play by the rules, you'll get ahead. Unfortunately, interest rates, inflation, and the rising cost of living are increasingly tightening the financial vice around so many Australian families.

I am deeply concerned about the impact of rising interest rates on hardworking Australians. Between 2011 and April 2022, interest rates did not rise once. In the last 15 months, Australians have faced 12 interest rate rises, with interest rates increasing from 0.1% to 4.1%. Those interest rate rises, as well as inflation and the rising cost of living generally, mean that a typical Australian family with a mortgage is now \$25,000 worse off than they were this time last year.

This is directly affecting the tens of thousands of people across the Berowra electorate who own their home with a mortgage.

At the last census in 2021, the median mortgage repayment in

Berowra was almost \$700 per month higher than the statewide median. At the time, almost 20% of Berowra residents were



paying more than 30% of their household income on mortgage repayments. That number is even larger today, as interest rates continue to rise and wages remain stagnant.

This doesn't just impact younger Australians attempting to break into the property market, or families who are struggling to meet their mortgage obligations at the same time as raising children. Increasingly I am hearing from parents and grandparents who are fortunate enough to own their home outright, but are deeply concerned about the financial vice that their children and grandchildren have been placed in. I will continue to advocate for the State and Federal Governments to do more to support our local community during this exceptionally difficult economic period.

SHIRE COMMUNITY CENTRES GO SOLAR

Hornsby Council has installed a total of 68.6kW of solar systems at Arcadia Community Centre, Berowra District Hall, Cherrybrook Community and Cultural Centre, Mt Colah Community Centre and Thornleigh Community Centre to save close to \$15,000 in electricity bills each year and generate 85MWh of energy.

This solar-power switch was funded through developer contributions. By integrating these new solar panels combined with Council's current solar systems, the Council's solar portfolio now reaches an impressive capacity exceeding 270kW.

Hornsby Shire Mayor, **Philip Ruddock** AO said, "Generating renewable energy is one way that we work to achieve our target of net zero emissions by 2050. We are also buying 100 per cent renewable electricity for Council buildings and street lighting."

Meanwhile, HORNSBY AQUATIC AND LEISURE CENTRE is also set to switch to solar, with solar panels set to be installed later this year.

These solar initiatives are part of Council's Sustainable Hornsby 2040





The Steiner's Berowra Boatshed

In the quasquicentennial (125th year) of the original boatshed on **Berowra Creek**, located at the ferry ramp on the eastern side of Berowra Waters, we look back at the ten-year period that **Ulric and Anne Steiner** owned and managed the boatshed business.

Ulric and Anne purchased the boatshed off **Kevin Fletcher** and his wife. The Fletchers had owned the business for the previous decade, but it was looking tired and had become dilapidated.

Ulric had emigrated from Switzerland, sailing out to his new country, in a yacht he had built himself. Here he met his Australian bride, Anne, whose family was involved in the marine industry.

The Steiners knew they faced a huge challenge to bring the two old buildings back to life whilst reinvigorating the boatshed business. However, they did have some support. Berowra Waters residents Roger Campbell and his wife Merrilee were friends of the Steiners, and they lent their substantial support to the project.

In addition to the Campbells, the Steiners had the services of the 67 year old **Reg Croft**. Former racehorse strapper, Reg, lived with his wife in Granville. Since 1954, every Friday afternoon he took the train out to Berowra and made his way down to Berowra Waters, which was his paradise. He spent his time picking up litter, sweeping and keeping the general area and boatshed clean and tidy. He collected and crushed all the discarded aluminum cans he could so these could be recycled and provide him with a small income.

Reg slept on a makeshift bed in the boatshed and would return to his home on Monday morning. The Steiners learnt that by purchasing the boatshed business they also inherited Reg Croft and his voluntary services. Ulric made the lovely old man a proper sleeping area in the upstairs section of the larger boatshed.

This larger boatshed was built 1937 when it replaced an older version. By 1980, it had begun to sag into the water and the floor often flooded at high tide. Its foundations had to be rebuilt as a priority and they poured concrete and replaced all the decking, as well as installed some additional windows to provide improved lighting inside.

The original and smaller boatshed was erected by Jack Smith in 1898, after the building was relocated from its original site in Leichhardt. It was transported by rail to Brooklyn. From there it was loaded on a boat and brought up to *Frank's Bight* on Berowra Creek. It was up and operating a full four years before *Berowra Creek Road* was opened to traffic. *The Steiners saw that this building also needed substantial work even though only really used as storage for their boatshed operation.*As well as Ulric building, maintaining and repairing his boats, a retail business was established in the larger shed. The shop was called, "*BOAT SHOPPE*" and it offered everything required for an angler as well as sold a wide variety of marine antiques, that the Steiners sourced from various places.

Available for hire at the boatshed were 15 motorboats and around 8 row boats. Some of their skiffs were the original ones made by Jack Smith out of Huon Pine. Smith had quality craftmanship and as a result these boats had lasted over 80 years and, after some maintenance from Ulric, were still going strong.

The boatshed had its regulars who had been regularly hiring boats there for decades. One of these was Welsh born, Berowra resident, **Norm Bromley**. Every Monday evening Norm would turn up at the boatshed with a bunch of flowers from his garden. He would hire his skiff to go out fishing for bream and return later, the same night, to pay his \$4 hire fee, as well as leave the Steiners any extra fish he had caught. This was a routine that rarely varied despite inconsistent weather.

The boatshed also provided 46 moorings and offered a slipway for repairs and shipwright services. In 1984, Ulric and Anne purchased an old waterfront home across the other side of the creek in *Silverwater Estate*, where they raised two girls. Ulric did a lot of work on this property including adding a second storey. However, after a while the isolation of Berowra Waters became too much for the family and in 1989, they sold the boatshed business and a few years later they relocated up to the bushland ridges of **Galston**.


The new owners did not operate the boat hire and repair business. *The old boatshed was converted to a restaurant, and this continues today.* Unfortunately, the large boat shed was demolished in 2013, to construct a retail operation with short term accommodation on top. However, the construction was not complete and due to it now being part of a deceased estate, the future of this site remains unclear.

Ulric & Peg Aispur, Kiwi river resident married to Vic the Russian

The smaller, original boatshed celebrates its quasquicentennial this year and is currently operating as an Italian restaurant called, "A CHEF SECRETS".

HOMEOWNER FALLS FROM ROOF RESULTING IN SERIOUS INJURY

TONY FROM TIGER ANTENNAS SAYS ..

Already this year we have heard from customers about four incidents in the Hornsby area of serious injury caused by the homeowners falling from their roofs.

Usually it's when a homeowner wants to inspect something (such as tiles or solar panels), clean the gutters etc. A couple of the accidents we heard about have resulted in life-long injuries. Most falls are by men in the age range of 45-65 years.

Statistically there are more falls in autumn and winter months. Most injury from falls are from single-storey homes – homeowners tend to be a bit more blasé with single storey roofs and spend less time thinking about safety precautions.

SO, WHAT CAN YOU DO TO MINIMIZE THE RISK? Preferably pay a professional. You can save money by getting one person to check a few things for you. *For example,* an antenna technician can check your tiles, gutters etc *if you ask nicely.* If you do pay a professional, **make sure they are insured.**

If you insist on going up on the roof yourself then at a very minimum: 1) only go up when your roof is completely dry (many roofs are wet with dew until mid-morning) 2) wear appropriate footwear (with a good grip) 3) always tie off the ladder at the top 4) as soon as you are are on the roof, move away from the edge.

Member for Hornsby, Matt Kean MP, recently spoke in NSW Parliament to recognize one of the Hornsby electorate's most impressive

emerging young athletes.

Tara Coopman is certainly a name to watch out for in the world of women's AFL. She is simply 'a star in the making'.

Recently at Hornsby's Rofe Park, Tara Coopman, or 'TC', as everyone calls her, notched up a rare achievement when she played her 100th junior AFL game with her club, *Northwest Lighting.*

The young *Hornsby Heights* resident joined the **Hornsby Berowra Eagles Junior AFL Club** as an eight-year-old in 2017 and played her first season in their mixed U9 team.

2018 saw the successful amalgamation of several local junior AFL clubs to improve development of their girls and through that, the Northwest Lightning Junior Girls AFL club was established. The new club's first *Under 10* age group team formed that year and TC managed to play in both that team and the Hornsby Berowra Eagles *Under 10* mixed team. Since then, she has played exclusively in Northwest Lightning girls' teams as she has progressed through the age groups.

Tara is acutely aware fitness is key in AFL and she can often be seen running in the local area and around Rofe Park early in the morning.

The **Asquith Girls High School** student is an extraordinary and talented AFL player having regularly played up age groups. This year she was rewarded for her hard work and dedication by being selected in the U/15 **Youth Girls Sydney Swans Academy.**

In addition to being a talented player, since 2021, TC has been a qualified umpire and officiates AFL games for both private schools and community clubs. In her first season of umpiring, she was awarded, **BEST FIRST YEAR UMPIRE.**

TC has been recognised with numerous awards over the years, regularly picking up Best and Fairest and Players Player trophies at end of the season presentations. However, her most prestigious recognition was last year when she received Hornsby Berowra Eagles, CLUB PLAYER OF THE YEAR.

TC's mum, **Leanne**, has been involved with running Hornsby Berowra Eagles club for eight years, and today she acts as the Club's Northwest Lighting alliance convener.

This year Tara trained in the pre-season with the Pennant Hills senior ladies' team and took a lot out of the coaching sessions led by **Mark Carroll**.

The Hornsby Berowra Eagles Club has consistently produced talented junior AFL players such as Tara, and keeps many of them involved with the sport after graduating from their junior ranks, such as Riley.






