

2077 AFTER DARK TRANSFORMS OUR NIGHTLIFE EXPERIENCES

A diverse range of *going-out* districts are set to emerge across Greater Sydney with the NSW Government announcing the first successful recipients of the **Uptown Grant Program.**

Minister for Music and the Nighttime Economy John Graham said 21 successful districts across eight different local government areas in Sydney will each receive up to \$200,000 to coordinate their efforts and build further consumer engagement.

Mr Graham said, "Owners have enough on their plate with the dayto-day running of their businesses. The Uptown Grant Program allows these districts to hire dedicated resources to manage their combined initiatives, including events, marketing and operations." LOCALLY, the Hornsby Chamber of Commerce and Liquor Accord will collaborate to enhance the 2077 postcode region's night-time economy, engaging with other nighttime industries once momentum is built. The 2077 A.D. - Hornsby After Dark will benefit from an injection of \$200,000.

President of the Hornsby Chamber of Commerce, John Warren said, "The Hornsby Chamber of Commerce is extremely proud to be leading the 2077 After Dark campaign with the strong support of our newly formed District Team including Hornsby RSL Club, Magpies Waitara, The Asquith Club, The Hornsby Railway Hotel, The Bluegum Hotel, The Hornsby Inn, Westfields Hornsby, Event Cinemas Hornsby, Hornsby Shire Council and The Bush Tele."

"2077 After Dark's mission is to breathe new life into the evening hours, revitalising the local nightlife economy and igniting a vibrant sense of community in the town centre," John Warren said. "We are committed to creating an inclusive and dynamic after-dark experience, where businesses thrive, and residents and visitors alike are drawn to the allure of our bustling environment."

Hornsby Mayor Philip Ruddock AO said, "Council is delighted to have been able to collaborate with the Hornsby Chamber to secure funding for this important project to invigorate Hornsby and the surrounding suburbs and ignite the night-time economy in the 2077 postcode, greatly benefiting Hornsby Shire. OUR LOCAL SKIPPER, NAT TOBIN LEADS SYDNEY FC TO THE 2023 A-LEAGUE WOMEN'S CHAMPIONSHIP

Berowra local, Nat Tobin, has captained Sydney FC's A-League Women's team for the past two seasons, as part of her inspiring football story.

Growing up in Berowra, Nat attended primary school at **St Bernard's** and completed her High School at **Mount St Benedict College**. She played her junior football with the **Berowra Football Club** until she was 9 when her extraordinary talent was identified, and she was selected for the Under 12 junior Rep team at the **Northern Tigers**.

Nat later played for *North West Sydney* teams, **NSW Institute of Sport**, represented **Australian Schoolgirls** at 15 and progressed through to the **Young Matildas** ranks.

As a substitute, Nat made her **A-League** debut at just 16-years of age for **Sydney FC** in the **2013 Grand Final**. *On that day, her team were crowned Champions with a 3 – 1 win over Melbourne Victory.* **Fast forward a decade and Nat Tobin has just won her third A-League Championship with Sydney FC.** This time she led her team as they secured the 2023 A-League Women's Championship with a dominant 4 – 0 Grand Final victory over Western United.

Nat Tobin, who, despite her relatively young age of 26, is the eldest member of the team and is described as a veteran. In the Grand Final she also celebrated her 100th appearance for her club and to complete a very special night as she managed to score a memorable goal in the 18th minute of her team's victory.

Having won A-League Championship victories in her very first game and



most recent game, Nat Tobin has also tasted disappointment playing in four losing Grand-Finals for her club against some star-studded sides. In Nat's two years as captain, Sydney FC have won 3 major trophies including back-to-back Premierships and a Championship. They have also smashed the leagues clean sheet record, which Nat was instrumental in, playing as a Centre Back.

Despite playing top level club football in a national competition, Nat still has to work fulltime as an occupational therapist. This shows female sport still has some way to go in order to support their stars with a fair and reasonable payment level.

INCONTINENCE IS MORE COMMON THAN YOU MAY THINK

Following extensive community and stakeholder engagement, I am pleased to advise that Council has formally adopted a revised draft Master Plan and the draft Plan of Management for our Westleigh Park project. The redevelopment will create a major parkland with spaces for play and sporting activities, and a choice of unstructured recreation experiences including mountain biking, walking and cycling, while conserving important bushland areas.

We are pleased to take this significant step forward in advancing our vision for Westleigh Park. Council received many submissions when the Plans were exhibited earlier this year, demonstrating strong community interest in the project.

We worked hard to consult extensively with the community, and I thank everyone who has contributed. We look forward to providing an outstanding experience for the community while ensuring the long-term protection of the bushland.

Community engagement remains central to everything we do, and we currently have several important projects that we are seeking your feedback on.

At our 14 June General Meeting, Council endorsed two studies, recommended in the Comprehensive Heritage Study aimed at protecting and interpreting Hornsby Shire's rich heritage, for exhibition. The draft Aboriginal Heritage Study and draft Heritage Interpretation Strategy and Action Plan will be on public exhibition for community feedback until 4 August.

At the same meeting, Council endorsed Agritourism Development Control Plan amendments to the Hornsby Development Control Plan 2013 for exhibition until 4 August.

NATIONAL CENTRE FOR CHILDHOOD GRIEF

Sadly, one in 20 Australian children will experience the death of a parent before they reach adulthood, and even more the death of a loved one. These experiences are one of the most traumatic that a child can endure. The grief and adjustment can shape a child's life with ongoing impacts to emotional and mental health. Unfortunately, these often go underrecognised.

We are fortunate to have a local *not-for-profit*: the **National Centre for Childhood Grief**. Over almost three decades, it has provided thousands of families with bereavement counselling and care in a nurturing and supportive environment. The Centre is also the national leader in child bereavement education and training.

At the Centre, children, teens and adults are supported through individual play and talk-based therapy, group sessions and targeted events with professional counsellors and also through meeting others who understand their experiences. It is a service that is changing the trajectory of lives through connection and understanding.

The Centre was founded by **Dianne McKissock** OAM and **Mal McKissock** OAM in 1994, both internationally recognised experts in the field of child bereavement and grief counselling. Now **Dr Elizabeth Mann** leads a team of professional counsellors, along with the board of directors and volunteer support workers.



I was able to recently visit the Centre's new premises near *Hornsby Hospital* and see the warm, welcoming safe space they have cultivated. We extend our gratitude to all the staff and volunteers for this incredible, vital service you provide to our community. 

Training is the best form of communication we have with our beloved pets. Many dogs suffer from confusion and anxiety trying to fit into the human environment, but we can ease this with clear communication on how we expect our dogs to behave.

- When in a public place, make sure your dog has a collar with a tag attached with its name and your contact information. Ensure your dog is under the control of a competent person holding an adequate leash.
- If your dog defecates in a public place, be sure to collect and dispose correctly.
- Make sure your dog is properly trained if in an off-leash area.
- Ensure your dog is registered. The NSW Government requires owners to register their beloved pet by six months of age.

GIZMO'S STORY

"THE BUSH TELE HAS ASKED ME TO WRITE MY STORY, BUT WHERE DO I START?"

Perhaps I will start my story at the beginning, when I was loved and so special. I was brand new, full of life and even though I left my mummy at only 5 weeks old, I had found another family to love me. Toys...I had so many, cuddles too! I was adorable, so they said. But sadly, after a while everything changed.

I peed in the house. My little teeth were sharp! My family left me for long hours and I was lonely. I barked and barked. I played with washing on the line and I dug great big holes.



When my daddy came home, he would scream at me, put my dinner down and then go inside. I used to watch through the door, my family. I loved them so much but somehow their love for me had died. One day a man came and took me away. I had been advertised "FREE TO A GOOD HOME". My mummy cried a little and said, "What a shame it did not work out. I never realized puppies were so much trouble!"

My new family wanted me to be a 'watchdog', and tied me up to make me angry. I got used to being cold and hungry. Again, I barked and barked - it seemed to get some attention! But my daddy would hit me with his newspaper, and I learnt about fear.

One day a car pulled up, and I was dragged over. My dad said, "This dog's good for nothing! We've given him a few months, but he will never make a watchdog." I was homeless again but this time it was a place with many dumped pets, just like me.

At just 12 months old my new home was a pound.

I was not socialized with other dogs. I had been isolated for long periods of time. 'Reactive', they called me in the pound. I was not lead trained or

housetrained. I had also become a 'fear biter' which means any sudden movement scared me. It seemed my short life had ended, but one day a gentle man came to me and after a few pats, he carried me to his car.

I had been RESCUED by a place called Monika's DoggieRescue, and as we drove off, the kind man said to me, "Don't worry mate, you are going to a good place this time." So, have you guessed what I am yet? No,

I'm not just an abandoned dog now (though I



have been twice), and I'm not just a 'rescued dog'. I am a 'LONG TERM' dog. DoggieRescue has many dogs like me, the dogs who are hard to place and need special families. Sometimes these dogs can take a very long time to find a home, but as DoggieRescue is NO-KILL we are all safe. After I have settled in and started to trust again, my training will start. I WILL BE ON THAT LONG ROAD WHICH FINALLY WILL TAKE ME TO MY FOREVER HOME!
