WHY AED?

The Community Defib Project installs community accessible defibrillators to vulnerable communities.

The project is a not-for-profit organization, founded by Paramedic Sophie Wills.



Sophie (pictured top right), currently leads the Project as Chair and founded the initiative in 2019, following a tragic medical event in 2018 on the outskirts of Wisemans Ferry.

With the desire to install one community defibrillator for the community of Wisemans Ferry, Sophie, as a Paramedicine student at Western Sydney University, sought help from **Dr Paul Simpson** (Director of Academic Program - Paramedicine at Western Sydney University). With the aspiration of purchasing one community defibrillator for Wisemans Ferry and with the understanding that "with every minute that goes by during a sudden cardiac arrest without a defibrillator, the victim's chance of survival is reduced by 7-10%" it was clear to Paul and Sophie that one community AED was not going to be enough.

Sophie and Paul soon facilitated a meeting with interested local parties including the Wisemans Ferry Forgotten Valley Inc, representatives from Wisemans Ferry Bowling Club and Wisemans Ferry Rural Fire Service.

The Project then expanded to include the **Maroota**, **St Albans** and **Spencer** communities as a pilot for the project.

The project now reaches more than 50 communities with more than 200 community members volunteering their time to bring the project to their community. The project has successfully installed 150+ community AEDs with many more planned across multiple communities.

ADDITIONAL AED INSTALLED AT BROOKLYN

"An AED (automated external defibrillator), also referred to as a defib or defibrillator is a device that can be used by anyone to respond to a sudden cardiac arrest victim. A sudden cardiac arrest is a medical emergency which describes the event where the victim's heart stops beating blood around their body. A SCA requires immediate intervention from bystanders.

Bystanders must CALL, PUSH and SHOCK.

Call for help - Push on the chest, hard and fast (CPR) and shock with the nearest defibrillator.

With every minute that goes by during a sudden cardiac arrest without a defibrillator, the victim's chance of survival is reduced by 7-10%."

The Community Defib Project (CDP) continues its work throughout the Brooklyn community led by the incredible CDP - Brooklyn Committee led by Jo Scarsbrick. Founder of CDP, Sophie Wills, said, "A huge congratulations to the Brooklyn committee who has successfully raised more than \$13,000 for the Brooklyn community since their inception in early 2022."

The Brooklyn committee has proudly funded 7 community AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORs (AED) for the Brooklyn community, with more to come.





ARTIST WENDY PRINCE TO EXHIBIT AT THE COTTAGE, BROOKLYN

Local landscape artist Wendy Prince is set to exhibit at The Cottage, Brooklyn from September 30 until November 5. On weekends it will be open from 10am-3pm.

With over thirty years of experience as an artist and three exhibitions under her belt, Wendy is looking forward to bringing her work to Brooklyn and the wider community. Wendy describes her practice as 'predominantly intuitive' as her work does not depict specific locations but rather is based upon her observation and experience of Sydney and NSW costal scenes and cloudscapes. The early Australian Impressionists and the English artist William Turner have been major inspirations for Wendy's work in both subject matter and surface treatment.

Wendy's work uses a subtle palette, and is a study of colour, space and texture. The media used ranges from conventional to the non-traditional. Wendy uses a range of mediums which include watercolour, acrylic, oil and encaustic. These mediums create opaque, semi-transparent and semi-translucent surfaces. The scale of work ranges from the Australian Impressionist vignettes of 9 x 5, to the largest at 70 x 40. Wendy says, "My love of texture and painting has evolved over many years into a study of emotive landscapes."

NEW BIODIVERSITY PROJECT FOR THE BIRDS AND THE BEES



Ku-ring-gai Council is trialling an initiative called a WOODY MEADOW developed by *Melbourne University*.

Woody meadows are diverse and densely planted areas created with flowering native plants, specifically designed to improve the quality of urban landscapes.

With their high number of flowers, woody meadows encourage insects such as native bees, small birds and other wildlife.

As well as being visually appealing woody meadows can reduce weed growth and maintenance costs for public land.

In August, the Council's environmental staff and 14 local volunteers planted 400 tube stock in St Ives Chase to create the trial WOODY MEADOW.

The plantings will develop over the next 12 to 18 months and Council staff will monitor the site to test whether biodiversity is increasing through more sightings of insects, birds and animals.

"LUCY" TRIGONOMETRICAL STATION

HUNT RESERVE, MOUNT COLAH

Story by Colin Choat

I live in Mount Colah.

Recently, a neighbour asked me if I knew whether there is a "trig" station in Mount Colah, or whether there used to be one.

I was able to tell him that there certainly was one. The original marker was described by Aidan de Brune, the first person to walk around Australia

On the second day of his walk, coming from Sydney, de Brune noted in his travel diary:

"21 September 1921. Visited Hornsby, Asquith, Mount Colah, Kuring-gai, Berowra, Cowan. Arrived Hornsby 10.10 a.m. and left at 11 a.m. To Asquith and Mt. Colah--669 ft. (197.6m.) above sea level. About a mile past station and 100 yards off left side of road a black disc on stones marking highest point of Mt. Colah..."

Since reading de Brune's description of the marker, while researching a book which I was writing about him, I had often wondered where the "marker" was located. Hunt Reserve, on the corner of the Pacific Highway and Beryl Avenue, was a likely spot, as it could be said to be "about a mile past the station and 100 yards off the left side of road". However, I could not locate any evidence of the existence of the trig.

I was, therefore, very surprised, during a stroll through Hunt Reserve, after recent improvements by the Council were completed, to see, beside a concrete path running through the reserve, an interpretive sign proclaiming the site of the "Lucy" Trigonometrical Station.

A trig station is a fixed surveying station, used in geodetic surveying and other surveying projects in its vicinity. The one in Hunt Reserve is said to indicate the second highest point in the Sydney suburban area. Mostly trig stations are situated on mountains and high hills and, whilst Mount Colah is a "mountain", it must be unusual, perhaps unique, to find a trig station within a Sydney suburban park. Still, it would probably have been just a paddock when Aidan de Brune walked past it 100 years ago. The original trig was constructed in 1882 and consisted of a cairn of stones, a post and a disk. In 1891 the government gazetted an area of three acres around the "trig" as "Trigonometric Reserve No. 13316". In August 1973 the stone cairn was demolished, and the underlying marker, a brass plug, was covered with a cast iron box, which remains today. While now recognised as "Permanent Survey Mark PM1250", Lucy Trig is still recognised as trig station No. TS 2904.


The interpretive sign erected recently gives the name and number of the trig, its elevation (197.6m) and the co-ordinates of its position (33°39'50.0"S 151°07'21.1"E.), as well as a short history of its creation and changes made to it. The council has done a great job in providing the sign and highlighting the trig point, which is still housed in the cast iron box.

The box has been set in concrete and the lid has been painted yellow.

WHY I BECAME INVOLVED IN RELAY FOR LIFE

KAREN HUMPHRIES' STORY



After surviving stage 3B metastatic *Cholangiocarcinoma* (a rare cancer of the Gallbladder/Bile Duct) in 2022, I decided to become a **HORNSBY RELAY FOR LIFE** (HRFL) participant that same year.

Along with my team, I personally wanted to help contribute to being an active member of society regrading changing the status quo for all cancers.

After reaching out to the HRFL committee about holding a stall for my **Socks4Cancer** initiative, which was set up to raise funds for *Cholangiocarcinoma* that I started doing during my six months of chemotherapy, I was asked to read the opening **Oath** and to also be the 2022 KEYNOTE SPEAKER. I was very honoured to do these two roles. As a result of the above, in 2023 I officially become a dedicated HRFL committee member.

Being diagnosed with a rare cancer and being given only a

20% five-year chance of survival was a hard pill to swallow.

The majority of cancers have a 95% five-year survival rate however the reality is that most Cholangiocarcinoma patients die within the first twelve months. The reason for this is that these cancers have no early detection testing, lack of both Government funding and awareness for more than forty years, and they are often found in later stage when it is too late for effective treatment. These facts activated the advocate in me, and I knew that I had to give my 'living voice' to this cancer.

In February 2023 I created Australian history by holding the FIRST REMEMBRANCE SERVICE and got twenty-six buildings lit up green in honour of Cholangiocarcinoma Cancer

Month and Awareness Day. To date, I have raised over \$14K for the NORTH Foundation -The Royal North Shore Hospital Professor Samra Department, The Pancare Foundation, and the Cancer Council, NSW Hornsby for Life. I have undergone 6 months of chemotherapy, the urgent removal of my gallbladder, an appendix abstraction, and a radical lymph node removal. Even though I have still have a long way to go, I am very grateful to be alive today, especially with the knowledge that my cancer would have actively travelled to my blood next as it has already spread.

I URGE EVERYONE TO PARTICIPATE IN HORNSBY RELAY FOR LIFE 2023.

Come and walk in honour of people like me, in honour of those who are no longer with us or in honour of someone you personally know. Help us make change and allow your participation to bring HOPE to many. Be a part of an amazing community that collectively brings about change.

IS SPRING GETTING **UP YOUR NOSE?**

Traditionally, Spring is said to be the start of the peak season for hay fever (allergic rhinitis) with airborne pollutants and newly sprung pollens blown into our noses.

Signs and symptoms of hay fever usually include sneezing and an itchy, runny or congested nose. The eyes might be red, puffy, itchy and watery, too. Prevention of hay fever by avoiding trigger factors is the best option. However, that's not always possible.

There are some medications which may help the symptoms of hay fever including:

- ANTI-HISTAMINE MEDICATIONS may be useful to control sneezing and itching, but are not as effective as sprays to control a severely blocked or runny nose
- CORTICOSTEROID NASAL SPRAYS help reduce the inflammation
- SALINE NASAL RINSES help remove allergens in the nose and relieve congestion.
- DECONGESTANT NASAL SPRAYS useful for quick relief, but should not be used long-term.
- EYE DROPS may relieve itchy, swollen or runny eyes.

Some of the most effective treatments such as corticosteroid nasal sprays can take a while to reach their full effect. So, if you are prone to hay fever now is the time to speak to our pharmacists about controlling your symptoms this Spring. It is also important in the current environment to be alert for COVID-19 symptoms and to not assume that they are 'just hay fever'.

Easy Care Gardening (ECG) is a not-for-profit, volunteer-led organisation that has helped maintain the gardens of older people who need assistance in the Ku-ring-gai, Hornsby, Ryde and Hunters Hill areas, since 1988. Without the help of volunteers, ECG would not be able to provide this service to the seniors living in their own home, who wish to enjoy their garden safely and with a level of independence.

WHAT DOES EASY CARE GARDENING SERVICES MEAN TO THE **COMMUNITY OF HORNSBY AND BEYOND?**

Easy Care Gardening has been operating in the Hornsby Shire since 1990. We have hundreds of Easy Care Gardening clients who are serviced by dozens of wonderful volunteers. And throughout the Hornsby Shire, I can confidently say that Easy Care Gardening successfully undertakes its mission of helping people who are older to remain in their homes longer, by providing gardening services, conducted largely by volunteers.

I know this because my 85 year-old neighbour Carmel, has been the recipient of the services of Easy Care Gardening for the past 4 or 5 years, and she loves it!

Carmel lost her husband 15 - 20 years ago but, despite her advanced years, she is still very fit and active. She has always had a beautiful garden which she is extremely proud of and she is often giving me great advice about my own garden.

Whilst Carmel gets out into her garden several times a week, she cannot do everything she could 5 or 10 years ago. To have her Easy Care Gardening team come to her property for 3 or 4 hours, a couple of times a year and do the jobs



she simply cannot manage means the world to her.

The volunteers will sit with her while she explains what she would like done. After some expert advice and feedback, the workers get in to the garden to do the work exactly as requested by Carmel. And all this work is provided at a very affordable rate to someone who is on a limited budget.

The social experience this service offers, to both the clients and volunteers, should not be undervalued.

One of the early volunteers in the Hornsby Shire was my late friend Jim Hatfield. I know Jim really enjoyed his time as an Easy Care volunteer, which spanned for 15 years from 1991 (when he was 63) through to 2006, when he "retired" at the age of 78.

Jim Hatfield was extremely proud of the service he provided, and he received several awards, including the Premier's Individual Community Award, for his work with ECG.



THE 2002 BUSHFIRES IN THE HORNSBY SHIRE

Living in the Bushland Shire has many advantages – its natural beauty, fresh mountain air, beautiful scenery, close-knit and caring community – but with its benefits, comes responsibility. That responsibility rests upon all residents to be Bush Fire Prepared. Even though many residents would have experienced serious bushfires endangering life and property in past years, a significant number in our community are unaware of, or do not fully comprehend, the full impact of a bush fire event.

Hornsby Shire Councillor Nathan Tilbury has written this historic account of the bushfire in 2022. Please take a moment to read it and consider what YOU would do in the event of bushfire.

CIIr Nathan Tilbury writes:

Following two years of drought, NSW was experiencing extremely dry conditions. On Wednesday 4th December 2002, another Total Fire Ban had been declared with hot, dry and windy conditions.

At about 3pm a bush fire was reported in Maroota South. This was followed by an additional report of a fire at Lower Portland. Soon after the first firefighting units arrived on scene at Maroota, dry grass burst into flames and was fanned by very gusty westerly winds.

The fire pushed to the east, made a run directly towards *Old Northern Road* towards **Glenorie** and soon after a third fire was reported at **Kenthurst**. Various RFS brigades from *Hornsby and Hills* were quickly dispatched to the impacted areas. They were supported by brigades from *Cumberland, MacArthur, Warringah and the Blue Mountains* areas.

Under the conditions it was clear that the fires could not be contained, so the priorities were to preserve lives and properties. With this in mind a crew from Glenorie RFS arrived at a property but they were directly impacted by the head of the fire and were forced to retreat. Driving through flames and dense smoke, the vision was very poor, causing their vehicle to crash into the side of a house that was already on fire. The driver and crew were trapped inside the truck, as flames surrounded them.

Other crew members arrived and made their way towards the crashed truck. On their way they encountered two ladies who were escaping the burning house just before the garage collapsed. All crew and the two women crammed into an RFS four-wheel drive car and made a brisk escape, back through the fire.

Old Northern Road was being impacted by fire, with local residents and motorists surrounded by fire.

At one point 15 civilians, including young children and injured fire fighters were forced to take refuge in a brick house as the fire front approached; fire crews remained outside to protect the house.

The Maroota fire raged towards Arcadia, Berrilee and Berowra Waters. RFS Crews went from property to property attempting to manage the fire around buildings and protect lives.

Eventually, after several days, the Lower Portland Fire, Maroota and Kenthurst fires would all combine into one blaze.

Around 40 homes were destroyed on the first day of the fires alone. 2 Civilian deaths were recorded, including a 72-year-old man who died of a heart attack as the fires raged near his home. He was found by his neighbours, slumped over the wheel of his tractor on his property on Cattai Ridge Road, Glenorie.

Later a second man was found dead in his caravan near Maroota. He was 81 years of age.

On the afternoon of Thursday 5th December 2002, the fire started to spot across Berowra Creek and made a run towards Cowan. Later that evening another spot fire impacted Berowra and Berowra Heights. While this was happening, several houses were destroyed at Berrilee.

Residents near bushland areas in Berowra were on standby, waiting for the fire to approach. As requested by the RFS, many residents whose houses faced onto bushland took the day off work to prepare and help protect their properties. In addition, local schools were closed. Residents were on roofs hosing them down, clearing gutters and packing their cars. They could see the fire on the ridges in the nearby national park and feared that late in the afternoon, when winds were expected to pick up, that they would be in the fire line.

The extreme danger from the approaching bushfire forced the closure of both the F3 Freeway and the Pacific Highway. In addition, the railway network north of Hornsby was closed.

Glendale Road, just south of Cowan, was the first area to be impacted. A macropod research centre located on the former Glendale farm site had prepared well. The station researches the behaviour of kangaroos and wallabies and the 200 animals on the site were relocated to the largest enclosure, so they had the best chance of escaping burning areas. Staff took shelter in the building on the property but had to flee outside as the corner of the house kept catching fire.

When the fire front passed, they found just one swamp wallaby perished and a NPWS firefighting truck destroyed. The main building was saved by a sprinkler system. Given the intensity of the fire it was remarkable the damage was minimal, and it was thought the *hazard reduction burn*, performed earlier in the year by NPWS, saved the research station from being destroyed.



Considerable support from the RFS and NSW Fire & Rescue were deployed to protect Brooklyn. In Berowra Heights, on Thursday night, voluntary evacuations started at around 7.40pm. Residents in homes along Turner Road and in Alston Drive were up all night as they were repeatedly threatened with embers blowing in creating fires in bushland directly behind their houses and even in their gardens From locations, such as Barnetts Lookout, groups of residents could only watch as flames slowly burnt down the bushland hills on the western side of Berowra Creek and, eventually, the fires crossed over to the Berowra side towards their homes.

Residents in Berowra Heights awoke on Friday morning to discover they were still in the firing line. At the end of Turner Road, Coreen Close and Alston Drive residents felt the full impact of fire with flames licking houses. The RFS successfully defended properties to ensure no houses were lost, but not without a struggle.

Later in the day conditions worsened with strong southerly winds fanning flames up the valleys to put Arcadia Crescent, and Barnetts Road under threat, and there were forced evacuations at Brooklyn.

In the Berowra and Brooklyn districts, *helitankers* repeatedly dropped water in residential areas that were under serious threat from the raging fires. As residents and firefighters desperately battled to save homes, sighting the "Incredible Hulk", was a very welcome sight. *It helped save many homes throughout the day.* The Pacific Highway and railway remained closed, but the Freeway was reopened.

The weekend brought milder conditions and residents were encouraged to use the opportunity to prepare for far worse conditions on Monday. Brooklyn was left without power, and the SES brought ice into the village by boat. At Berowra containment lines were tested, but held.

Monday did not bring the feared catastrophic conditions. There was some fire activity at Berowra with residents of **The Gully Road and Warrina Street** subject to small blazes that were controlled.

Tuesday gave firefighters the respite they desperately needed with rain. This provided the opportunity to turn over smoldering debris to expose them to the downpour.

It was later said of the fires that threatened the Berowra, Cowan and Brooklyn areas, "hundreds of houses would have been lost if it wasn't for the bravery of firefighters and residents, supported by the helitankers." In the end, incredibly, no homes were destroyed in these areas.







RAY AND EVELYN CUNNINGHAM CELEBRATING 100 YEARS OF LIFE, AND 70 YEARS TOGETHER

Within the space of one week, local couple Ray and Evelyn Cunningham are about to celebrate two exceptional milestones – Ray's 100th Birthday on 21 September, and the couple's 70th Wedding Anniversary on 28 September. Evelyn and Ray met in Evelyn's father's house in 1944 when Ray was home for further training based at Wagga after serving on the Kokoda Track. Ray was with the 14th Field Co. Engineers of the Australian Army's 9th Division, while Evelyn was on holiday from university. The pair didn't marry until 9 years later, in September 1953. "I was just so slow in asking her to marry me!" Ray says.

A constant of their life and marriage has been their deep faith in God. While on the Kokoda track, Ray met a Papuan man who completely changed his perspective on Christianity. "I vividly remember my friend and I speaking with a Papuan man while hiking along the Track. For him, faith in God wasn't about being a Christian it was about carrying Christ within," Ray said. "Those conversations with him changed my perspective on God and my life completely. After they married, Ray and Evelyn served with the Borneo Evangelical Mission in the East Malaysian State of Sarawak amongst 4 different tribal groups, each in their own language and culture. In those early years, all travel was by river. During their time in Borneo, Ray worked as an ordained Baptist minister, visiting the longhouses,

teaching a new way of life and translating the Scriptures. Evelyn, who had some training in Linguistics, was able to work out a scientifically accurate orthography for two of the unwritten languages. With reading primers, the local children could then learn to read in 6 weeks. Evelyn said, "Focusing on communicating in their heart language was crucial for them forming strong bonds with the people they met while in Borneo." Both Evelyn and Ray could speak several tribal languages.

"One of the most important things that I have learned in my life is that at the heart of every human problem is a problem of the human heart." Their two children, **Gwen and Kathy**, were born in Borneo. The birth of their first child was a particularly terrifying and ultimately memorable experience.

Evelyn recalls, 'While I was waiting at our Mission base for the birth of our first child, Ray was visiting longhouses in the interior. He caught typhoid fever and nearly died."

"He had to be airlifted to the **Shell Co. Hospital** in **Brunei**, the only hospital in our area. I was then also taken to this hospital for the birth of our child and, thankfully, all the family ultimately emerged from the ordeal healthy and well."

Ray and Evelyn have lived in the local area since their return in 1991 and in Rowland Village in Galston for the last two decades.

When asked about the secret to their long



marriage and lives (Evelyn is only a few years younger than Ray), both Evelyn and Ray credited their deep faith in God.

"For us, marriage isn't according to whim. We believe in the covenant 'til death do us part,'" Ray says. Evelyn adds, "Above all, we stick together and we support each other."

Eating simple, straight-forward meals is also one thing that both Ray and Evelyn credit to their long life, although they do still love chocolate!

Neither have ever been big drinkers. Evelyn says, "We learned early that freedom from grog means freedom from trouble."



Almost 70 years since their wedding, and with his 100th Birthday fast approaching, Ray and Evelyn remain very much in love.

"I can't speak too highly of the girl that God gave me."

LAPIDARY CLUB'S NNIVERSARY ROCKS

SINCE ITS HUMBLE BEGINNINGS IN A CHOOK SHED IN NARARA HALF A CENTURY AGO, the Central Coast Lapidary Club has grown to be one of the Coast's real treasures.

This year the Club is celebrating its 60th anniversary.

Since the inaugural meeting at founding members Charles and Margaret Pate's home in Gosford in 1963, when around 25 people attended, the Club now has over 200 members and a permanent

home in Ourimbah.

While the techniques and machines haven't evolved much, the Club now has lots more than it started out with, all located in Club headquarters which was built by Club members in 1978.

The Club also hosts an annual gem show. The event attracts thousands of Gem fans from far and wide. STORM SEASON IS APPROACHING

Severe storms are the most damaging and expensive natural disaster in Australia with the associated dangerous winds, flash-flooding, and hail, as well as the frequency and likelihood to hit areas with high population density.

According to the *Insurance Council of Australia*, the 1999 Sydney hailstorm remains the second most expensive natural disaster in the nation, with insurance claims totalling \$5.5 billion, behind the February and March 2022 east coast flooding which cost more than \$5.65 billion.

The NSW State Emergency Service (SES) is the first to respond to storms, floods, and tsunami events as well as assisting in rescue efforts. We are fortunate to have both the Hornsby Unit and the Ku-ring-gai Unit locally.

Whist I have frequently visited the Ku-ring-gai SES Unit, the Hornsby Unit based at Thornleigh is now within the Wahroonga Electorate after the redistribution. In a recent visit to the Hornsby Unit Headquarters, I was impressed by the comprehensive training that members undertake. This Unit has supported our local community since 1958 and currently has approximately 100 members, all of whom are volunteers. We are indebted to them and their willingness to share their expertise and time and it was a pleasure to have the opportunity to thank some of them personally.

Storm season runs from October to March so now is the best time for us to prepare. The SES recommends that we maintain our outdoor areas, including the clearing of gutters, trimming of trees, and maintaining of roofs, and that we make an emergency plan. Further details are available at www.ses.nsw.gov.au

Additionally, the **HAZARDS NEAR ME APP** is a great way to stay informed with warnings and advice about bush fires, hazard reduction activities, fire bans, and floods.





Robin Timmins, who passed away recently, was a much-loved member of our conference.

She was a long-serving Secretary of the **Berowra FEC** as well as a long-serving Secretary of the Pennant Hills Branch. She held that role in the Branch for over 30 years. Later, Robin was President of the Dural-Oakhill Branch of our Party.

Anyone who would ring Robin would hear a message on her answering machine saying, *"This is Robin and the Tweetie Pies - go the Woodies!"*. **Robin was awarded an OAM in part for her Services to Rugby Union, but also for her long service to the Party.**

No election campaign, no FEC meeting, and no event was complete without Robin's steadfast presence and good counsel.

Robin organised the regular lunches that the Dural-Oakhill Branch would hold at the Pennant Hills Bowling Club, or the afternoon teas and cocktail parties they would hold at the home of one of their members. She organised the heritage walking tours too. Robin was also somebody who would warmly encourage her friends to be involved in the Party.

She was a great supporter of Phillip Ruddock AO, Barry O'Farrell, Matt Kean MP and myself. We would see each other regularly at the Pennant



Hills shops and I would get her thoughts on the politics of the day. I always appreciated her counsel.

Robin was a proud and passionate Australian, and she expressed her love for our country by getting involved in our Party. We are first and foremost a volunteer party, and Robin was one of our truly great volunteers. Our community and party is richer because of Robin's long-term involvement. We are all the poorer for her passing.

Jonathan Sacks often said a community is where people know your name and miss you when you aren't there. We all knew Robin and we will miss her


