EXTRA FUNDING FOR A NEW & IMPROVED HORNSBY HOSPITAL

Bush Telegraph readers are the first to see the new Schematic Design for the Stage 2 Redevelopment at Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Hospital.

The drawings show how the additional services promised at the last state election will be incorporated into the **Clinical Services Building**.

Member for Hornsby **Matt Kean** committed an additional \$65 million in funding to expand the new Clinical Services Building which will see a number of services offered to the community for the first time.

"We had already invested \$200 million but the staff told us that we needed to go further, so we did," Mr Kean said.

The additional funds will allow for:

- a consolidation of **community health services**, along with the expansion of **outpatient services** which will enable the Hospital to provide **chemotherapy services** and **renal dialysis** for the first time
- new **oral health** and **BreastScreen** centres
- the fit-out of **two rehabilitation inpatient units**
- the **Psychiatric Emergency Care Centre** will be expanded
- and a **HELIPAD** will be provided which avoids the need for patients to arrive at nearby James Park.

Clinical Director **Dr Pip Middleton**, said, "The services we are adding will make a huge difference to the level of care we are able to provide our patients and the entire community.

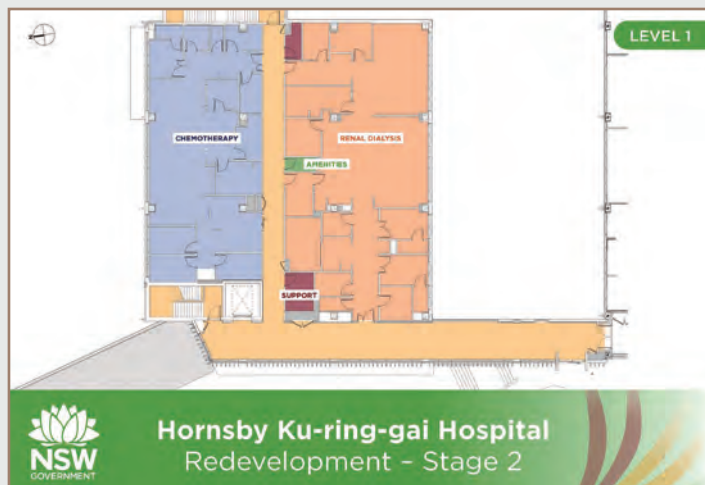
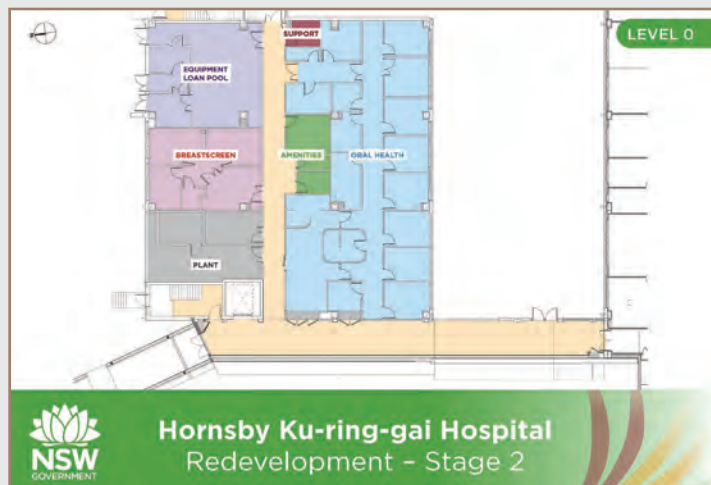
"If you compare what we had and the new ICU open now you can see what a difference this has made."



Construction of the new **Clinical Services Building** is well underway with the new paediatric unit, outpatient services, pathology, pharmacy and the ICU all operating out of the new premises.

"The new ICU is around three times the size of the existing unit, allowing for a more efficient workflow and providing better patient-centred care," Mr Kean said. The Clinical Services Building is on track to be completed in 2021 with work to commence on the additional services once the building is complete.

HORNSBY'S MP MATT KEAN DELIVERS LANDMARK ENERGY LEGISLATION

Member for Hornsby **Matt Kean** has put NSW on the map with his energy bill passing through Parliament after a marathon 30 hours of debate in the upper house.

The landmark legislation will mean thousands of new jobs, billions of dollars of private sector investment and New South Wales will be able to access some of the cheapest electricity in the world.

The Government's **Electricity Infrastructure Investment Bill 2020** and the **Electricity Infrastructure Roadmap** that it enables, will cement NSW's spot as an energy and economic superpower.

"This Bill will allow us to get on with delivering the energy infrastructure we need to keep the lights on and get electricity prices down for homes and businesses across our great State," Mr Kean said.

"And it will deliver the modern, cheap, reliable energy grid that will power NSW into the future and underwrite our prosperity for generations to come."

"We know that in the next 15 years four of our five generators will come to the end of their technical life. The energy roadmap is a plan to replace those generators with new technology that will keep the lights on and drive down household bills," said Mr Kean. "The plan will deliver families and businesses in New South Wales some of the cheapest energy in the world."

"Industry and investors will now have the certainty they need to invest in the generation, storage, firming and transmission capacity we need – with more than \$32 billion of private sector investment to be injected into the NSW economy by 2030," Mr Kean said.

"It will help to create the jobs of the future, with 9,000 direct jobs by 2030 and more than 23,000 indirect jobs – mostly in the regions – in the next decade.

CALABASH BAY DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION REFUSAL

the details

As reported in the November edition of *The Bush Tele*, many Berowra Creek residents and regular visitors finally had some very good news in 2020 to hear that the DA in Calabash Bay, to develop four remote housing blocks, had been refused.

This highly controversial DA, united nearly all river residents against it and, hopefully, this means that Calabash Bay will remain in its current natural state. After 4 years of deliberation, the news from the *Deputy Secretary of the NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment* is that he will not grant concurrence to the proposed subdivision in Calabash Bay and accordingly, the application was been refused by Council.

The proposed sub-division was on a 43.38 hectares bushland site of primarily pristine bushland supporting a range of vegetation communities. **Calabash Bay has an extensive sandflat at low tide and a channel along the foreshore frontage of the site.** The site includes Aboriginal relics including a midden on the foreshore. Along with the abundant indigenous heritage the subject site also has significant European heritage which includes the legendary Fretes ruins.

This controversial DA was for a boundary adjustment and proposed four allotments, all with water front access. The proposal also included construction of two jetties and pontoons.

Calabash Bay is a magic location on the western shore of Berowra Creek downstream from Dusthole Bay.

WHAT IS NEXT? I am sure the applicant is currently considering all their options and they do have a right of appeal to the *Land and Environment Court* within 12 months.

REASONS OF REFUSAL

1. The Department of Planning, Industry & Environment has determined that concurrence not be granted for variation of the lot size development standard pursuant to the provisions under State Environmental Planning Policy No. 1 – Development Standards (SEPP 1) in respect to:

1.1 The proposal is inconsistent with the provisions of Sydney Regional Environmental Plan No. 20 – Hawkesbury-Nepean River that seek to limit the disturbance of vegetation and protect scenic quality and recreational and tourist uses of the river.

1.2 The proposal is unsatisfactory pursuant to SEPP 1 Clause 8(b) as the proposal is likely to adversely impact the public benefit by potentially limiting public access to the western section of Calabash bay and impacting the scenic and environmental qualities of the western section of Calabash Bay including the estuary.

1.3 The Department has concerns with the intensification of residential development in an area constrained by lack of vehicular access combined with potential site specific boat access issues including limitations to NSW Rural Fire Service vessels during periods of low tide.

LATEST HAPPENINGS FOR HORNSBY'S HERITAGE AND HISTORY

OUR BUSHLAND

In April 2020, Hornsby Council endorsed the commencement of a comprehensive heritage study program, the first since 1991. *A study of this scale, which will include indigenous heritage, will take a number of years to fully complete.*

The heritage review will commence with an update on thematic history of the local area, which provides a broad historical context for understanding the patterns and forces that shaped the Hornsby Shire.

As a contribution to Hornsby thematic history experienced local historian **Tom Richmond** and I have been compiling a short history on every suburb in the Hornsby Shire.

Tom and I have had excellent contributions from other local historians who are very familiar with their own local area which has allowed us to expertly cover the entire Shire.

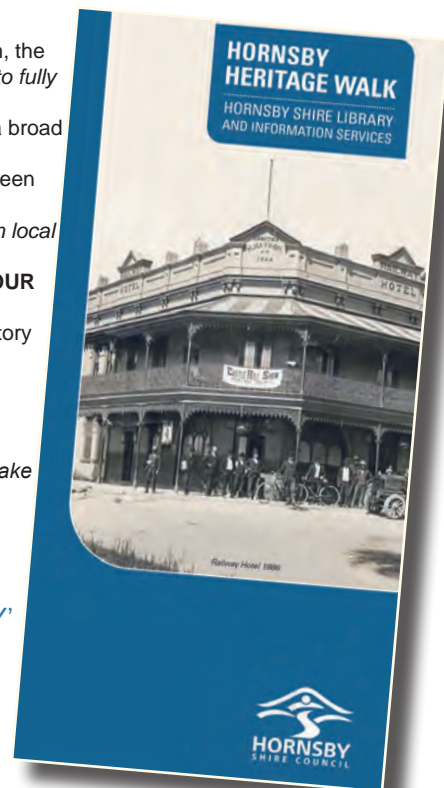
After presenting the work to Council's consultant we are now pulling it all together into a book called, "**OUR BUSHLAND SHIRE**" which is aiming to have ready for purchase in the first quarter of 2021.

The "OUR BUSHLAND SHIRE" book is designed to be of interest to a much wider audience than just history buffs with each suburb 'timed' to be able to be read over 'a cup of coffee'.

HERITAGE WALKS

In addition, Hornsby Shire Council is putting together a number of Heritage Walks with the first being the **Hornsby Heritage Walk**. Available now, this self-guided historical walking tour takes in 26 locations of significance around the Hornsby CBD area (both east and west side). *It is a nice, flat walk which should take approximately 90 minutes.* You can pick up a brochure of the Hornsby Heritage Walk from one Council's libraries or download it from Council's website.

The next HERITAGE WALK to be prepared will be around the **historically rich Brooklyn area** which promises to be a cracker!

SHARED BIKE PATHWAYS MAKE RIDING IN HORNSBY EASIER

Riding your bicycle through Hornsby is about to get a whole lot easier now that new shared pathways will be linking **Hornsby Town Centre to Hornsby Hospital** and all the way up to **Hornsby Heights**.

The NSW Government has confirmed more than \$1.7 million in grants to build the first new shared path along **Edgeworth David Avenue**, and a second one along **Peats Ferry Road**, linking with the existing path on **Galston Road**.

Matt Kean MP said, "We want to be able to see more people able to safely walk or cycle as part of their commute each day. These upgrades will ensure this is possible."

"The people of Hornsby Shire are very grateful for this funding from the NSW Government, as well as another \$400,000 that will create a similar cycleway in Cherrybrook," **Mayor Philip Ruddock** said.



- * voting was conducted via survey monkey with only a few postal votes needing to be sent out. Out of 189 members, 121 voted - an excellent response.
- * the wood turners held regular demonstrations via Zoom when in-person numbers were severely limited in the middle of the year. *These Zoom sessions have been such a success that the turners want to continue offering them.*
- * membership has increased 10% this past year which is a lot more than in any other year! The age range of members has widened too with our youngest member a 16 year old female and our oldest are two 93 year old males!

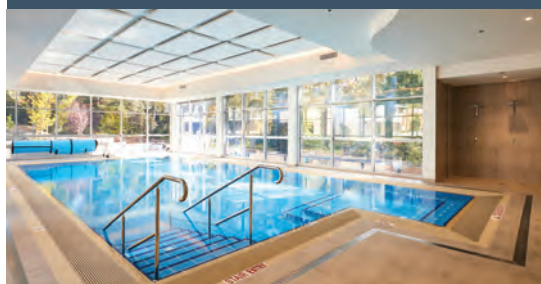

MEMORIES OF BEROWRA WATERS



The BWPA was established in 1933 and has operated consecutively for 87 years.

I was privileged to attend the **Berowra Waters Progress Association's** (BWPA) AGM on Sunday 6 December 2020 as their guest speaker. Whilst living on **Berowra Creek** is a wonderful experience at times it is not easy and "river residents" know they have to stick together and help each other to get through the many challenges that they are constantly faced with in a boat access only community. The BWPA is a very well run organization with a strong membership base. I admire the river residents' community's resilience and strong spirit of co-operation which achieves great results such as the reuse of the old **Kiosk/ Tea House building** for a community facility and **saving the Calabash Bay** area against excessive and inappropriate development. As their guest speaker, I spoke of some of the projects for the Berowra Waters area that never actually eventuated.

These included:

* The original proposal for the road which, in 1893 was drawn up on maps to run along the ridge (that is today Currawong Road), and proposed to wind its way down to south of Washtub Gully, where it would cross the Creek to a road along the foreshore of Silverwater Estate (south of the ferry on the west side)

* A bridge over Berowra Creek to replace the ferry was first proposed by

Council in 1935 but was refused by the Lands Department. The bridge was unsuccessfully proposed many times between 1935 with the last proposal in 1971

* In 1936 there was a proposal for a tennis court in Dusthole Bay, rather than the boat ramp, parking area and marina that were eventually built in the 1970s and 80s

* Roads to proposed Crown Land housing developments along Berowra Creek including down to Bujwa Bay (today part of Muogamarra)

* Lock up garages along the foreshore was unsuccessfully proposed several times in the 1960s

* In 1974, to help with worsening parking issues, there was a proposal to establish a parking area in Berowra Heights and have a chairlift take visitors down and up between there and Berowra Waters. I am told, still today there are visitors that ask the ferry operators where the chairlift is located!

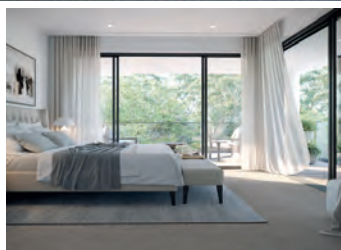
* In 1978, on the eastern side of Berowra Creek at Franks Bite, there was a proposal to reclaim the former swimming baths for additional recreation and parking

If any of these things occurred Berowra Waters would today be a very different place.

Congratulations to the new Berowra Waters Progress Association Executive, and I look forward to working with you in 2021.
