## COFFEE AT STOREY PARK, ANYONE?

The amazing adventure playground and new community centre at Storey Park in Old Berowra Road Asquith, have proven to be extremely popular attractions for both locals and visitors since the park was opened earlier this year.

I am pleased to report that at Council's most recent meeting my motion was supported to go out to seek *expressions of interest* for a **mobile food vendor** to provide Storey Park users the opportunity to purchase a coffee and food.

**I know from direct feedback from many parents visiting the adventure playground that having food and drinks available for purchase would be very welcome and further enhance their visit the facility.**

A café was originally planned with the new Storey Park facility before being removed later as a cost cutting measure. However, it was Council's intention of finding a way of offering food and drink once the facilities were open and the demand was proven to be there, so it is pleasing to have this commitment now followed through.

This is potentially a first step in having something more permanent on site at Storey Park as a café in the future.



## UPDATE ON COVID-19

**An Open Letter from Member for Hornsby Matt Kean MP (12/3/2020)**

I understand that people within the community have concerns about the current COVID-19 situation. I want to assure everyone that the NSW Government is well prepared and has plans in place to protect the community.

All agencies in the NSW Government have joined forces and senior officials are working together in one location to coordinate our response. NSW Health is providing expert advice, conducting testing and working to trace contacts of anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 to ensure that they too can be isolated and tested. These actions dramatically slow the spread in the community.

The Department of Education is working to ensure that in the event of school closures or if students need to self-isolate learning will be possible online. This work builds on the already strong online capabilities of our education system. The regular cleaning of our public transport system has been stepped up, particularly in major hubs.

It is important to remember that around 80 per cent of cases of COVID-19 have mild symptoms similar to a cold. Most infections are transmitted by people when they have symptoms such as fever, a cough, sore throat and shortness of breath.

The majority of cases in Australia at this stage are from returned travellers. Anyone coming from overseas who has transited through a high-risk country should isolate themselves from others for 14 days from the day of departure from the high-risk country. For the latest advice go to [www.health.gov.au](http://www.health.gov.au).

Anyone who has returned from overseas travel at all in the past 14 days should self-monitor for symptoms, practice social distancing as much as possible and immediately self-isolate if they become unwell. Social distancing means separating yourself from other people as much as possible when you're in public places, and avoiding crowded places.

The best defence against infection is to practice good hygiene, including: Washing your hands thoroughly and often for at least 20 seconds with soap and water, or using an alcohol-based hand rub where this is unavailable. Covering your nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing with tissue or a flexed elbow. Avoiding close contact with people known to be unwell. Making sure you stay home if you are unwell. Face masks are not recommended for the general public and should be reserved for people to use when they are sick to prevent them from infecting others. It is prudent to have a small supply of essentials in case you are required to isolate. Anything in excess of 14 days supply is unnecessary and we ask the community to be considerate of others.

## BUSHFIRE PLANNING WORKSHOPS FOR RESIDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Get Ready Ku-ring-gai  
bushfire awareness  
campaign.

RFS and Ku-ring-gai Council staff  
will host two workshops in April  
to help residents with disabilities  
prepare a bushfire evacuation plan.

The workshops are being held  
after consultation with community  
members, during which it emerged  
that local residents with disabilities  
felt they needed more support  
and guidance on what to do in an  
emergency evacuation.

The workshops profile the Council's  
innovative 'simtable' a 3D simulation  
which shows residents how a  
bushfire could start and spread in  
their local area.

Mayor **Jennifer Anderson** said,  
"These info sessions will also help  
us assess how prepared residents  
with disabilities are for evacuating in  
an emergency."

The workshops are on **Tuesday 14  
April** at the Council Chambers 818  
Pacific Highway Gordon between  
6pm and 7pm or **Wednesday 29  
April** between 10am and 12pm, also

## KU-RING-GAI COUNCIL OFFERS REBATES TO RETROFIT BUSHFIRE- PRONE HOMES

Ku-ring-gai Council is offering rebates of up to \$1000 for  
properties in bushfire prone areas so owners can retrofit their  
properties to better protect them against bushfires.

Over 14,000 houses in Ku-ring-gai are located in high risk bushfire and  
ember attack zones and are eligible to apply for the rebate.

The rebate scheme is being offered from now until 26 June 2020.

Homeowners can apply for up to \$1000 in funding to go towards  
retrofitting their homes with items such as toughened window glass,  
gutter shields and sprinkler systems.

To apply for a rebate, homeowners need to complete a pre-approval  
process, including a checklist of their home's current condition, a bushfire  
plan for their property and building approval if applicable.

Mayor **Jennifer Anderson** said the bushfire retrofit rebate scheme was a  
first for the Council and was part of Council's Climate Wise Communities  
program.

**Climate Wise Communities** aims to increase the local community's  
resilience to extreme weather events such as bushfire, storms and floods.

"Feedback from the community indicates that making a home more  
resilient to bushfires is expensive, so we want to help them take that first  
step to better protect their homes," the Mayor said.

"We also want to ensure that our community is prepared for more intense  
and unpredictable bushfires."

**Neil** and **Merle Davis**, all long term Berowra  
residents.

For five years Lewis has been working as  
the Environment Manager at **El Questro  
Wilderness Park** in the heart of the  
Kimberley region of Western Australia. Lewis  
came home to Berowra for some well-earned  
R&R. We were fascinated to hear of the  
wide variety of tasks that he and his staff  
undertake in this remote location of the far  
north of Western Australia.

Lewis screened some great photos of the  
fantastic scenery, the wildlife and the flora  
of this region, and told of his adventures,  
including relocating rogue crocodiles.

On one occasion he was stranded for three  
days when floods prevented him from taking  
his vehicle through to safety and he survived  
on native berries.

Helicopters are the preferred method of  
travel usually when he attends to duties  
including rescuing lost tourists.

# EXTINCTION REBELLION HORNSBY SHIRE PROTESTS CONTINUE

Extinction Rebellion Hornsby Shire held another successful protest outside the Hornsby Council Chambers on 11 March, despite concern in the community about the COVID-19 virus. **Protests will continue until the council declares a climate emergency, urging all levels of government to act.**

**Sarah**, from Extinction Rebellion Hornsby Shire, said, "The impact on wildlife has been devastating, as conservationists are suggesting koalas are endangered as their numbers have been reduced by two thirds over the past twenty years. It's vitally important we mitigate the climate crisis to help preserve their numbers as the link with bush fires further harms koalas."

Sarah also said there are very personal human issues affecting people's health and well-being, with conditions such as asthma on the rise, and people being anxious about the future.

**Councillors Vince del Gallego and Mick Marr** spoke with protesters, and **Councillor Emma Heyde** observed that people are worried about the coronavirus, but the effects of climate change are going to be much worse!

Local veterinarian **Bronwyn Walker** shared some information about wildlife and the recent catastrophic bushfires.

"Surviving koalas fared better on private land and the team found many clinging to the top of blackened trees with not a leaf in sight," said Bronwyn. Some kangaroos and wallabies on the edge of fires were able to escape but often had burns and injuries too serious to allow for eventual release. Very few native animals survived these unusually ferocious fires."

**Paul Souter**, President of the **Westleigh Progress Association** said, "At its last meeting the association moved that the new executive be empowered to explore ways to help people prepare for future bushfires. Many of the local residents expressed concerns about the lack of exit routes out of the area, with only one road which would become congested with cars, should a bushfire occur in the area. Residents also expressed concerns about the lack of evacuation centres during the bushfire season."

The Extinction Rebellion movement uses non-violent action to pursue three central demands. It is the fastest growing climate action group in the world.

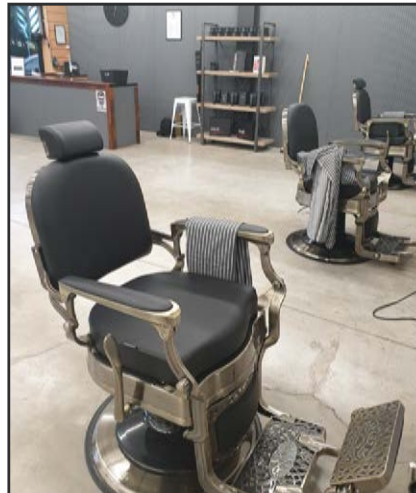

# COUNCIL UPDATES FROM WITHIN, & OUT & ABOUT

**GDAY FRIENDS.** We are experiencing troubled times again with the drought, storms that left many houses again damaged and without electricity or communication. On top of that we have the Coronavirus and everyone panic buying dunny paper and leaving locals with some difficult options. *The rains have been great and the bush fires are officially out.* Unfortunately not all areas of the State received this and many areas are still affected by the drought. I see a lot of our local volunteer RFS and SES are back from fighting fires but the remediation continues.

I have attended several community and site meetings some of which are discussed below including:

- **Senior Citizens Conference** at the Hornsby RSL had some fantastic dancing, singing and cultural events.
- **Information Meetings (PopUps)** relating to Sewage Management for those unsewered sites along the Hawkesbury River catchment and particularly along Berowra Creek. Council is re-introducing a checking and approval system for effluent treatment.
- **Hornsby Councillors Conference** at Sydney, where we tried to work through the many projects that this council has engaged in.
- **Re-cycling at Thornleigh Community Centre**, demonstrated repairs to furniture and electrical equipment.
- **HSC Bushland Advisory Committee (BMAC)**: looked at environmental factors relating to using synthetic sports fields and night lighting to increase times for usage. Also discussed **Byles Creek**, proposed **Westleigh sports fields** and implication of **mountain bike tracks** in environmentally sensitive areas and the fact that no single stakeholder will be 100% happy with the outcome.
- **HSC Sunset Sessions**: (very nice) at Hornsby Mall which were well attended.
- **Clean Up Australia Day in Berowra**: We started many years ago when the surrounding areas were littered with rubbish, especially thousands of plastic bottles. *Now there is far less and hardly any plastic bottles although we did come across a few Bongs.* Good on the community for helping to keep Australia beautiful. A large part of the improvement is the



10 cents levy on drink containers with a huge reduction in this area. But how about including larger beer and wine bottles in this deposit program?

► **Storm Damage**: The storm in February did a lot of damage, especially to those areas on the ridge tops. There were still leaking roofs from the hail damage in December 2018. *Not good.* Trees were down everywhere, power was out in many areas and there appeared to be a shortage of repair people. Hornsby Council Staff, emergency services workers and volunteers did a great job with getting the place working again. *Good Job.*

► **Catchment Remediation Rate (CRR)**: Had a look at some of the new CRR projects around Hornsby and Berowra. The CRR is a levy all ratepayers pay with the specific purpose of remediating and improving water quality of storm water going down the drains and into Berowra Creek. Essentially they capture rubbish, especially plastics and in some cases nutrients that come from fertilizers, dog poo and decomposing vegetation. One of these was at **Waitara Park** that also included a flood mitigation device which consisted of catchment areas leading under Edgeworth David Avenue tennis courts, that in a flood can fill up and flood water is released slowly into Hornsby Creek. *And most of the time it's used for recreation and no one knows it's there.*

► **Restricted Asset**: So after much discussion with various parties and residents I checked out what is a Restricted Asset Account. This was the account Berowra Pool money was put into that gained no interest in around thirty years despite many inquiries from the Berowra community. Residents were told all Restricted Assets went into one fund and don't gain interest. Well, funds put in these accounts do gain interest. However it is all pooled together and is used for projects shire wide as set out in Report No CS33/18. However *item 7* identifies that Council can direct interest to a specific project if it wishes to do so.

► **Weeds**: So the rain is very welcome and great for the bush and gardens. However the weeds are also thriving. Had a look at some of the Bush Regeneration areas including Asset Protection Zones (APZ) behind peoples' houses and found have millions of weeds growing. Many of these areas have these weeds because various state government departments staff/contractors use mower slashers that have spread the weed seeds from other areas to the ones they are slashing, especially in APZ's and then don't regularly mow the areas and the weeds seed again. Other weed infestations are caused by people dumping their lawn and clippings in the bush. **Put your green waste in the Green Waste Bin or compost it on your property.** So please don't use the bush as a tip. I'm told you can be fined for "DUMPING" and it reflects badly on the house occupants by those going past.

**I rarely respond to letter in local papers but I feel that misconceptions must be answered.**

I first joined Elouera Bushfire Brigade when I was 19. That was 50 years ago. I have been a member of Hornsby Heights Rural Fire Brigade since 1994. I was present in the 1972 Kosciusko Fires, 1977 Hornsby Area fires, the NSW 1994 Fires, the 1997 NSW Fires, 2001/2002 NSW Fires, 2002/2003 NSW Fires, 2013 South Coast and Blue Mountains Fire, just to name a few.

So, you may get the picture that I have seen a few quite dramatic fires, over the years. I can tell you that I never seen fire activity the like of these fires, ever before.

You mention the need for Hazard Reduction and that is true in many circumstances. However, like many other fire fighters this and last year I saw large sections of bush that had been hazard reduced, only eight months previously, burn with an intensity that made those fires uncontrollable.

I saw apple orchards burn with ferocity of a eucalyptus forest; pastures grazed to 10mm stubble burn with a metre high flame height. I saw even the soil burn. The speed at which these fires travelled was unprecedented. Friends have described how sections of bush burnt not once, but sometime twice in the same week.

The Bushfire Research Institute (CSIRO) fire behaviour parameters have been thrown out the windows.

Bushfires in Australia have been getting progressively worse since the 1990s. It is harder to get hazard reductions done, because as the RFS has stated on many occasions, the window is getting smaller.

Now, if you wish to practice your denialist religion, that is your prerogative, as it is mine to accept the data and interpretation of that data by 999 out 1000 scientists, who work in the field of climate science.

I am scientist and I despair at the age of de-enlightenment that we have entered, where charlatans and financially compromised pseudo-scientists are given equal air space as actual, qualified and experience climate scientists and ecologists. I won't comment about the shock jock community, most of whom did not finish high school.

Have your beliefs but let the decisions be made by people with training, qualifications and experience.

# MOBILE COVERAGE BOOST FOR MOUNT COLAH

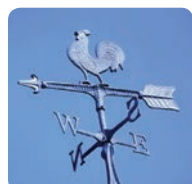

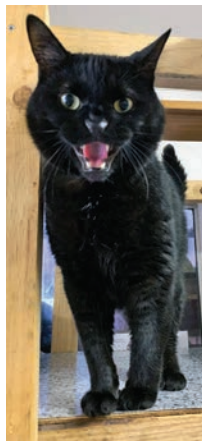
