Hornsby Council advises: BE PREPARED FOR EMERGENCIES ESPECIALLY IN BUSHFIRE SEASON

"If there's one thing 2020 has taught us so far, it's to expect the unexpected" Hornsby Shire Mayor Philip Ruddock

Hornsby Shire Council is urging residents to make sure their emergency plans are up to date, as part of the Red Cross' Emergency Preparedness Week.

Bushfires are high on the list in the Bushland Shire, but people also need to be ready for other emergencies such as flooding, extreme heat, storms and COVID-19 outbreaks.

Mayor Ruddock warns, "It's particularly important to be ready for the coming bushfire season, which could be even worse than last year's with much of the fuel still there in our expansive bushland."

BE PREPARED!

Research has clearly shown that people have a far greater chance of survival if they are properly prepared.

"There are all kinds of steps that can be taken, including very simple actions such as cleaning out your gutters and preparing a plan for if an event occurs, said Mayor Ruddock."

KMC PREPARES FOR LOOMING BUSHFIRE SEASON

Residents of Ku-ring-gai Council are being invited to join in a series of online workshops to help get their homes ready for dangerous summer conditions.

The community can take part in:

- * a bushfire retrofit presentation with architect Nigel Bell,
- * a bushfire home assessment screened LIVE from a local home
- * a 3D bushfire simulation workshop with the RFS

All three events are being delivered by Ku-ring-gai Council's Climate Wise Communities program, which builds local preparedness for extreme weather events through an innovative website at www.climatewisecommunities.com.au

The website generates personalised reports to help residents create bushfire survival plans and assess how prepared their properties are for bushfires.

The program also uses the innovative **Simtable**, which shows residents a 3D simulation of how a fire would start and behave in their neighbourhood. As part of its 2020 bushfire readiness program, the Council is offering local residents bushfire retrofit rebates, which can be claimed for any eligible retrofit changes made to a home that strengthens it against bushfire.

NORTHCONNEX UPDATE

EMERGENCY SERVICES GET INSIDE NORTHCONNEX

NSW Police, Fire and Rescue
NSW and NSW Ambulance
have been completing
emergency and incident
response training in preparation
for the opening of the
NorthConnex tunnel.

It is predicted that the risk of
crash is 5 times lower in the
tunnel than on Pennant Hills
Road and will be one of the first
motorways in Sydney to have
average speed cameras in the
tunnels for heavy vehicles.

Member for Hornsby **Matt Kean**
said Police and emergency services
will assist the incident response
teams in the tunnels and need to be
familiar with the layout as well as
the surrounding area.

"This is about making sure our
emergency services know how to
get in and around the tunnel in the
event of an accident," Mr Kean
said.

"NorthConnex is about making it
safer for every motorists so we can
all get home quicker and safer," Mr
Kean said.

Some of the safety features
in the tunnel include:

- **NorthConnex has its own suite of vehicles** available to assist drivers including Tow Trucks, Attenuator truck, utility and patrol trucks.

- **850 cameras provide 100% CCTV coverage:** including 750 in-tunnel, 20 in the Motorway Control Centre, 71 on approaching roads plus stopped vehicle detection cameras to alert of potential incidents.



- **The tunnels feature two vehicle cross over points,** specifically for emergency services in the event of an incident

- **Emergency cabinets** housing fire hose reels, hydrants and an extinguisher and phones located every 60 metres in the tunnels

- **Water deluge systems** throughout the tunnels can be activated in the event of an incident/ fire (see photo above). Heat detectors trigger the system, which will flow at thousands of litres per minute

- **Vehicle sensors and barriers** at the tunnel entries stop overheight and prohibited vehicles from entering the tunnel

- **Digital radio break-in communication systems** enables the operations team to directly communicate with motorists in their

cars to provide advice
"We're now on the *home stretch*, with road signs installed and covered over, and *Transurban* confirming NorthConnex will open in the 'third quarter'.

WEATHER CONDITIONS AID HAZARD REDUCTION IN HORNSBY / KU-RING-GAI

Favourable weather conditions across the Hornsby / Ku-ring-gai region have allowed the NSW Rural Fire Service (NSW RFS) volunteers to complete much needed hazard reduction burns.

NSW RFS Superintendent **Mark Sugden** said this will help protect local communities from potentially damaging bush fires.

"The Service is committed to protecting lives and properties by reducing bush and grass hazards," Superintendent Sugden said.

"Hornsby / Ku-ring-gai NSW RFS volunteers have been working hard in recent weeks, undertaking a number of controlled burns.

"Hazard reduction burns are weather dependant and while conditions remain suitable, NSW RFS volunteers will continue these activities.

"While we will do what we can to best prepare for the fire season it is important that residents do what they can to prepare their homes and properties as well.

"A few simple steps is all it takes and you should start by making a bush fire survival plan and discussing it with your family.

"Know your fire risk and what you and your family will do in the event a fire threatens.

Superintendent Sugden thanked local Brigades for their effort and commitment to the hazard reduction operations.

"NSW RFS members are on call 24 hours a day, seven days a week - ready to attend any type of emergency," Superintendent Sugden said.

"During busy periods our members give up a lot of their time and their dedication is admirable.

"While we should all be proud of their commitment, the community should also recognise the support of the volunteers' families and employers."

CAR PARKING HOTSPOTS TARGETED BY COUNCIL

Providing sufficient parking has always been a challenge for many Sydney Local Government Areas and Hornsby is no different. *Addressing a lack of adequate parking has been identified by many Hornsby residents as a priority across the Shire.*

Recently Hornsby Council undertook a major review of the current car parking usage across 17 precincts in the Shire and put together a "Car Parking Management Study".

The challenge for Council is to provide a balance between adequate parking supply and demand, to ensure long term viability of our town centres and destinations, whilst helping residents make a change towards active (walking & cycling) and public transportation.

Parking HOT SPOTS in the Hornsby Shire include:

- **Brooklyn** has a challenge with parking for both the river community residents and tourists. Many non-residents come through the area and utilize Parsley Bay where they park and launch their vessel. This could be a good opportunity for the implementation of paid parking for users who are not Hornsby Shire residents. Public transport to Brooklyn is expected to increase once the railway disabled access is completed.
- **Berowra Waters**, like Brooklyn, has parking issues for local residents, who have their own car parking area, and visitors to the popular tourist destination. On the weekends this is a particular problem on the eastern side of Berowra Waters.
- **Berowra** has issues with parking around the railway station through mid-week commuter parking. This causes issues with commuters parking along the Pacific Highway, both south and north of the railway station, and walking to and from their vehicle along the Highway, which can be dangerous. There have also been issues with commuters parking out community facilities and residential areas closest to Berowra Railway Station, such as The Gully Road (pictured above right) and Goodwyn Road. Also challenging is being able to provide enough short-term parking for residents using the commercial area around the Pacific Highway.
- **Pennant Hills town centre.** When **Northconnex** opens this area should enjoy relief from the current high traffic volumes, to the point where off-peak parking opportunities could be possible along Pennant Hills Road. Commuter Parking around Pennant Hills railway station has improved since the opening of the metro through West Pennant Hills.
- **Around Hornsby Hospital** has always been a problem for parking with many hospital staff and visitors parking out nearby residential streets and impacting on the amenity of local residents.
- **Waitara around the railway station** parking is at over 90% of capacity during peak periods because of commuters parking throughout the area. This is expected to potentially increase when the disabled access is installed at Waitara Railway Station
- **Hornsby Town Centre** has competing demands from Hornsby Railway Station and the shopping precincts which see both its on street parking and off street parking at over 90% during peak periods.



Part of the overall solutions for these areas will be encouraging the use of alternative transport options such as; using public transport, walking through the increased provision of footpaths and pedestrian refuges, increased cycling facilities and storage options and car pooling. Any recommendations implemented from the Parking Study will need to take into account changes that have occurred via COVID 19 impacts.

SENIOR HOUSING DEVELOPMENTS BANNED IN RURAL AREA

Hornsby Shire Council has chalked up a significant win, with the NSW Government banning senior housing developments in rural areas.

Mayor Philip Ruddock said, "Council has been lobbying hard for a long time to achieve exactly this result, saying for years that the senior housing developments are simply not appropriate for rural areas."

"There are a number of issues, particularly that they are not consistent with the character of the area and they are not well serviced by necessary infrastructure," said the Mayor.

Council played a significant role in the decision, which was made in response to a report by the *Greater Sydney Commission* into the cumulative impact of senior housing development in the rural areas of *Hornsby Shire and The Hills*.

"We are certainly not opposed to senior housing developments and strongly support their construction under the correct circumstances," said Mayor Ruddock, "but these essential housing options for seniors have to be in an appropriate location with adequate amenity."

The amendments to the State Environmental Planning Policy will take effect immediately, though applications that have already been lodged will continue to be assessed and determined.

HYDROGEN POWER

Hydrogen is to climate change what a vaccine is to COVID-19.
Put simply: a breakthrough that changes the world.

Since I took over as *Minister for Energy and Environment*, my goal has been to build a more sustainable future for our children, and to leave the world in a better place than we found it. I have been working hard towards this goal and recently released a report from the NSW *Chief Scientist* into the opportunities for NSW in a low carbon economy.

The Chief Scientist identified 65 economic opportunities across the key sectors of the state's economy, including services, energy, industry, the built environment, land management and transport. **There are many great ideas in this report and I would encourage those interested to read the full report.**

One aspect I would like to highlight in The Bush Telegraph this month is Hydrogen.

The **clean-tech buzzword in 2020 is hydrogen**. Hydrogen has been around for a century, used to refine steel and other metals. It was also used to power the *Saturn V rockets* that sent *man to the moon* while the first hydrogen fuel cells provided electricity and fresh water to the astronauts.

The spectacular fall in cost of renewable generation has rapidly accelerated the potential for hydrogen to play a critical role in our decarbonised future. Hydrogen can be produced by electrolysis water with electricity. If this process can get cheap enough, then abundant and cheap renewable energy can be used to make abundant and cheap



hydrogen. This green hydrogen can then be stored and used as a fuel to firm renewables in electricity and combusted to provide zero-emissions high temperature heat for industrial processes like steel and cement making. **It could power trucks, buses and cars, ships and trains.** We are facing a challenge like never before. We are going to need an unprecedented wave of spending to get our economy moving again. This is going to see governments borrow huge sums, effectively passing some of this debt on to future generations. **If we are going to impose this cost on them, we need to make sure that they will see the benefit.** I don't just want to see our children paying the interest on our debt; I want to see our children earning returns on our investments. If we really want to repay future generations with interest, then we should borrow to start rebuilding them a low carbon world today.

KMC AIMS FOR NET ZERO EMISSIONS BY 2040

"Ku-ring-gai will be providing residents with more education and resources to reach net zero emissions by 2040, or earlier"

Ku-ring-gai Council has beaten its 2020 target and now has its sights set on zero emissions by 2040.

Ku-ring-gai Council's Climate Change Policy and accompanying action plan were adopted by the Council at its August 2020 meeting.

The plan will support Ku-ring-gai's transition to zero emissions through wide-ranging community education and investment in proven and emerging technologies such as electric vehicles, rooftop solar and renewable energy.

Having already reduced operational emissions by 24% and annual energy costs by around \$200,000, the new targets mean the Council will aim for 100% renewable energy by as early as 2025 and net zero emissions by 2040.

Among the key actions proposed by the policy are:

- A commitment to respond to climate change challenges
- Aligning Council targets with the *Paris Agreement* and the latest climate science

- Investment in solutions to transform the Council's electricity supply, transport and energy use
- More support for the community to reach zero emissions.

"Initiatives will centre around the key areas of household and business energy efficiency, sustainable transport and waste reduction and will be developed in consultation with the community," said Mayor Jennifer Anderson.

CLIMATE ACTION GROUP CALLS FOR GREEN RECOVERY

Hornsby Shire Climate Action Group (HSCAG) recently made representations to the NSW State Energy & Environment Minister, Member for Hornsby **Matt Kean**, to express concerns over a proposal by mining giant Santos to locate 850 gas wells in the **Pilliga Forest**, near Narrabri NSW. The forest is home to several endangered species, including Koalas, and significant cave based indigenous art sites. The proposed project was slated to extract 37 billion litres of groundwater from the **Great Artesian Basin**, emit fugitive methane gas that is 86 times more damaging to the climate than carbon dioxide, and leave up to 840,000 tonnes of toxic salt waste with no acceptable disposal solution.

An independent motion to place a moratorium on coal seam gas mining was defeated in State Parliament earlier this year and Santos' proposal moved to the NSW Independent Planning Commission (IPC) for assessment.

The level of public concern over the proposal led to a totally unprecedented number of submissions being received by the IPC. The decision of the IPC is due on 30 September 2020.

Concurrent with the above proceedings, the Federal Government established the National Covid-19 Commission Advisory Board.

This Board is led by Chairman **Nev Power**, the former Chief Executive of Fortescue Metals Group and a current Board Member of gas company Strike Energy, and includes several other fossil fuel industry representatives.



HSCAG state that there is a far better alternative in pursuing a **Green Recovery**. A recent report by science based climate advocates *Beyond Zero Emissions* estimated that decarbonising the economy could create jobs for 355,000 people a year over the next five years. The report pointed to a range of immediately achievable actions, including: energy and water efficient building and infrastructure, increased investment in renewables, and improved agricultural practices that would lead to better results for both the climate and the economy. The report, titled the *'Million Jobs Plan'*, was received enthusiastically by large sections of the business community. "In other words, it's about putting the future of our children front and centre, while creating jobs and strengthening the economy," said HSCAG's **Estelle Dollfus-Gates**.

BEROWRA'S CAPTAIN TALBOT

Captain Robert Francis Talbot was born in Ireland in 1844 and died in Berowra in 1935.

Talbot joined the *Royal Navy* in 1860 and served all over the world including the *West Indies* (Port Royal), *American Civil War* and *Mexican War*. When being stationed in Sydney for a 3 year period, Robert Talbot (photo below) married **Annie Mason** in Sydney in 1873. After returning to England with the Navy he finally finished his obligations and Talbot returned to Australia in 1874.

Annie and Robert Talbot became early pioneer settlers at **Catherine Hill Bay** where he was originally a miner before establishing a pub there from 1875, which still trades today. He also established a general store and took over as postmaster in 1877.

By 1879 mining had collapsed at Catherine Hill Bay and Talbot transferred to the north to become postmaster at **Pelican Flat**. He quickly became a very influential resident and community leader. In November 1887 Talbot successfully submitted a name change to the Postmaster General, from Pelican Flat to **Swansea**.

In 1898, due to his wife's failing health, he sold his business and moved the family to North Sydney, in the hope of helping her recover. *By this time there were six children on the scene (3 boys and 3 girls) between the ages of 22 and 4 years of age.*

Unfortunately, Annie died in the family house in North Sydney, in July 1911, aged 58. **Soon after his wife's death, Robert Talbot sought a quieter life and moved to Berowra.**



He purchased land located on a bush track that ran off **Peats Ferry Road**. The bush track was known locally as **Wattle Road**, and later **Talbot Road**, until 1934 when it was formally named **Yallambee Road**.

At the age of 70, Talbot cleared his land while living there in a tent. *He eventually erected an early type of kit home (see photo below) with floorboards that slotted together and walls which slotted into the floor.* It was a very small house with a kitchen, lounge room and a separate bedroom, perfect for an old bachelor. The house was named "**Malehide**" by Talbot, after "**Malehide Castle**" in Ireland which was occupied by the Talbot clan for nearly 800 years.

He became locally known as "Captain" Talbot.

The residents of Berowra greatly respected the old naval man and he was called on to represent the community for events such as Empire Day and ANZAC Day. He took a keen interest in Berowra's children and instilled in them a lasting influence of the importance of God, King, National pride and of contributing to the community. He was also a *Justice of the Peace* which was a very valuable service to have available in Berowra in that period.

Captain Talbot was heavily involved in the planning and erection of the Berowra War Memorial. He had the honour of performing the unveiling ceremony on 26th March 1932 in its original location, on the verge of the Pacific

Highway near **Berowra Railway Station** (see photo top right). Two of his sons are listed on the Berowra War Memorial in **Hugh Talbot and Leslie Talbot** (photo right with Robert Talbot seated), in recognition for their service in WW1. The elder brother, Hugh, earlier had served in the *South African War* (Boer War) where he was shot in the chest but was saved as the bullet stuck in the buckle of his bandolier. *Years later Captain Talbot proudly displayed the belt and bullet in his Berowra home.*

Robert Talbot lived a very active life in Berowra for over two decades,

until his death 3rd January 1935 at the age of 92.

There is no doubt he was one of Berowra's most interesting and influential residents.

"Talbot Way" in the Illoura Estate, Berowra is named after Captain Talbot.

THANK YOU, PARAMEDICS!

Story: Helen Oakey

On Tuesday evening 11th August 2020, *without warning* **Peter Oakey** crashed to the timber floor at our home.

Thankfully, there was a loud bang which alerted family members. *For 20 minutes Peter lapsed in and out of consciousness.* At one stage he struggled to sit up saying: *'I can't breathe, I can't breathe.'* Then he collapsed again.

Triple 000 was called and the ambulance was on its way, but another emergency call was also made to our Paramedic friend **Steve Perryman** who lives close by.

Just before the ambulance arrived, Peter's colour changed to white, *then blue/grey.*

It was an enormous relief to hand over to the Paramedics when they arrived.

Paramedic friend Steve arrived about the same time. As it turned out, two ambulances each with two Paramedics in attendance, plus Steve, were all needed in the fight to save Peter.

We thought Peter was concussed from the fall, but later tests at Royal North Shore Hospital (RNSH) found he had suffered a heart attack resulting from a *Massive Pulmonary Embolism* (blood clot in the lungs) which stopped blood flow to his heart. The Paramedics could give no guarantee that Peter would arrive alive at the hospital, *but he did.* **They saved Peter's life.**

Doctors at RNSH were amazed that Peter lived through his ordeal, with one doctor saying that only 5% of patients with a Massive P E make it through CPR, outside of hospital.

Doctors commented that the Paramedics were 'Outstanding' and 'Awesome'.

The specialist in charge of Peter's case said, **'Let's just call you Lazarus'** – an apt name, as so many were praying for Peter. **Peter is expected to make a full recovery.**

Our family of 17 wish to publicly say a **MASSIVE THANK YOU** to those amazing Paramedics who saved Peter's life and our paramedic friend Steve. Their teamwork, and quiet - *on the surface* - calm efficiency (belied by the multiple ripped open plastic bags strewn everywhere) was incredible and we will be forever grateful.

Special thanks too to the dedicated and professional doctors and nurses at RNSH who go above and beyond.

Is SPRING getting up your NOSE?

Traditionally, Spring is said to be the start of the peak season for hay fever (allergic rhinitis) with airborne pollutants and newly sprung pollens blown into our noses.

Signs and symptoms of hay fever usually include sneezing and an itchy, runny or congested nose. The eyes might be red, puffy, itchy and watery, too.

Prevention of hay fever by avoiding trigger factors is the best option.

However, that's not always possible. **There are some medications which may help the symptoms of hay fever including:**

- Anti-histamine medications - may be useful to control sneezing and itching, but are not as effective as sprays to control a severely blocked or runny nose
- Corticosteroid nasal sprays - help reduce the inflammation in the nose.
- Saline Nasal Rinses - help remove allergens in the nose and relieve congestion.
- Decongestant nasal sprays - useful for quick relief, but should not be used long-term.
- Eye drops - may relieve itchy, swollen or runny eyes.

Some of the most effective treatments such as corticosteroid nasal sprays can take a while to reach their full effect.

So, if you are prone to hay fever now is the time to speak to our pharmacists about controlling your symptoms this Spring. It is also important in the current environment to be alert for COVID-19 symptoms and to not assume that they are 'just hay fever'. NSW Health recommends that anyone with respiratory symptoms, loss of sense of smell or taste, or unexplained fever should be tested for COVID-19.

The steel is recycled into new products, the wood is made into mulch, and the fabric is combined with crushed recycled glass to make high quality tiles. *These tiles can be used for ceiling insulation, acoustic panelling or other decorative elements for new housing.*

LEAPing into SCHOOL

Starting school, be it primary or secondary, is a big moment in any child's life, but it doesn't have to be scary.

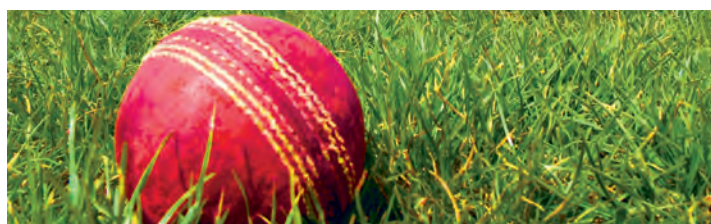

DRIVE THRU RECYCLING COLLECTION IN THORNLEIGH

When preparing your home for renovations, the dreaded 'clean up' of room contents must first take place. This is when the keen renovator may come across years of accumulated items which could be candidates for recycling.



Hornsby Council's drive-thru **Community Recycling Centre (CRC)** in Thornleigh collected 635,440 kilograms of problem wastes in the financial year 2019/20, with over 26,000 cars visiting the facility. These household problem wastes included over three million items of soft

plastics (as calculated by REDcycle). Council's **Thornleigh Community Recycling Centre (CRC)** is open, under appropriate COVID-19 Controls.

The CRC is open: Tuesday to Friday, 8.30am-4pm; and Saturdays, 8.30am-12pm. (Please check the Waste Hotline 9847 4856 to ensure the facility is open during COVID) It is located at 29 Sefton Road, Thornleigh.

The following COVID-19 control measures are in place:

- All CRC customers must stay in their vehicles until directed into a drop-off bay by staff.
- Hand sanitiser stations will be located at each drop-off bay.
- Customers will be required to self-unload their items and place them in the relevant receptacles as directed by Council staff.
- Customers must ensure they can self-unload their items without assistance from Council staff. Residents should bring along a member from their household to assist if required.
- All customers must maintain social distancing while unloading and depositing items.

If the CRC experiences high demand or excessive queuing within the facility, the front gates will be temporarily closed. Public enquiries can be directed to Council's Waste Hotline as normal on 9847 4856.

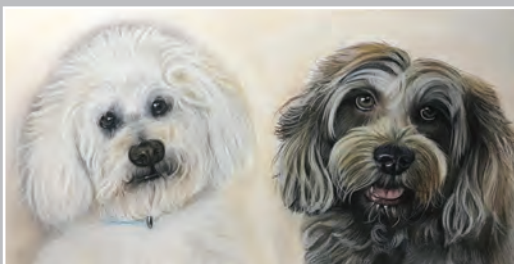

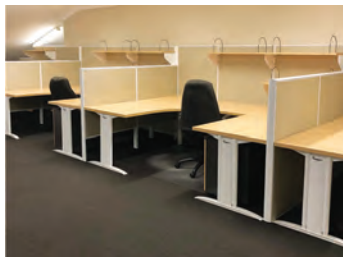
